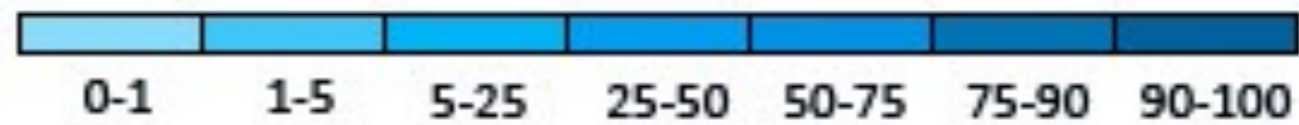
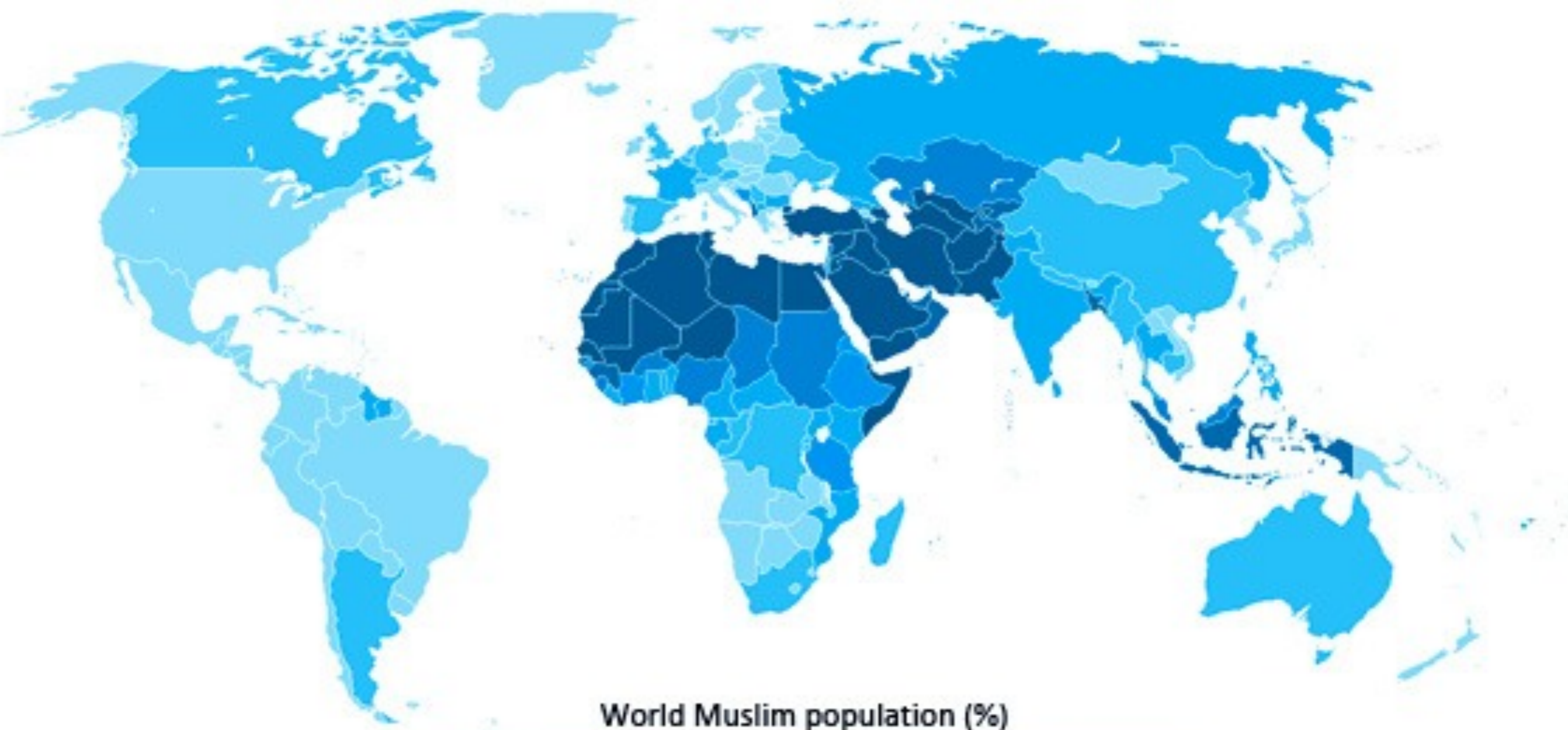


World Muslim population (%)



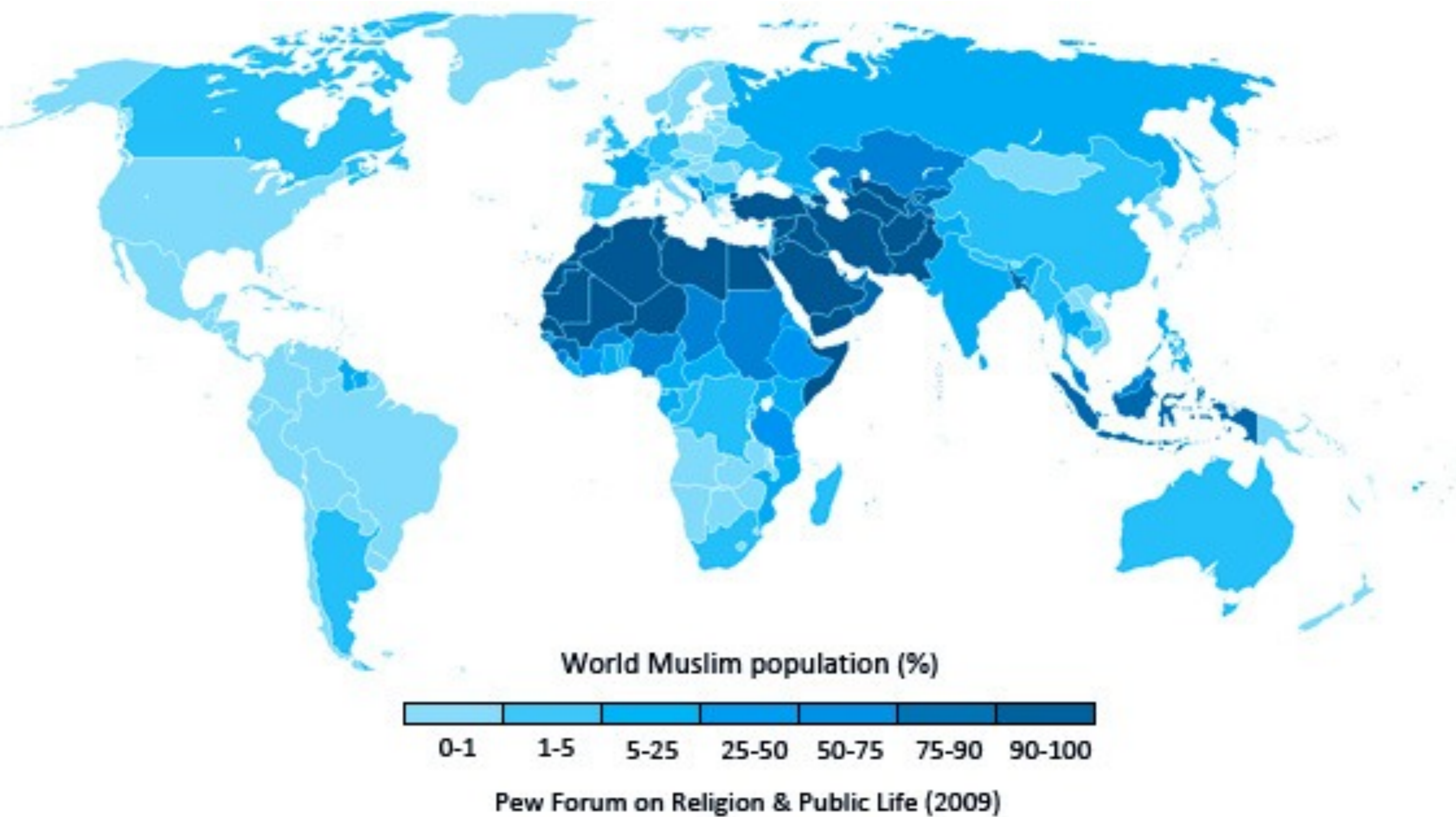

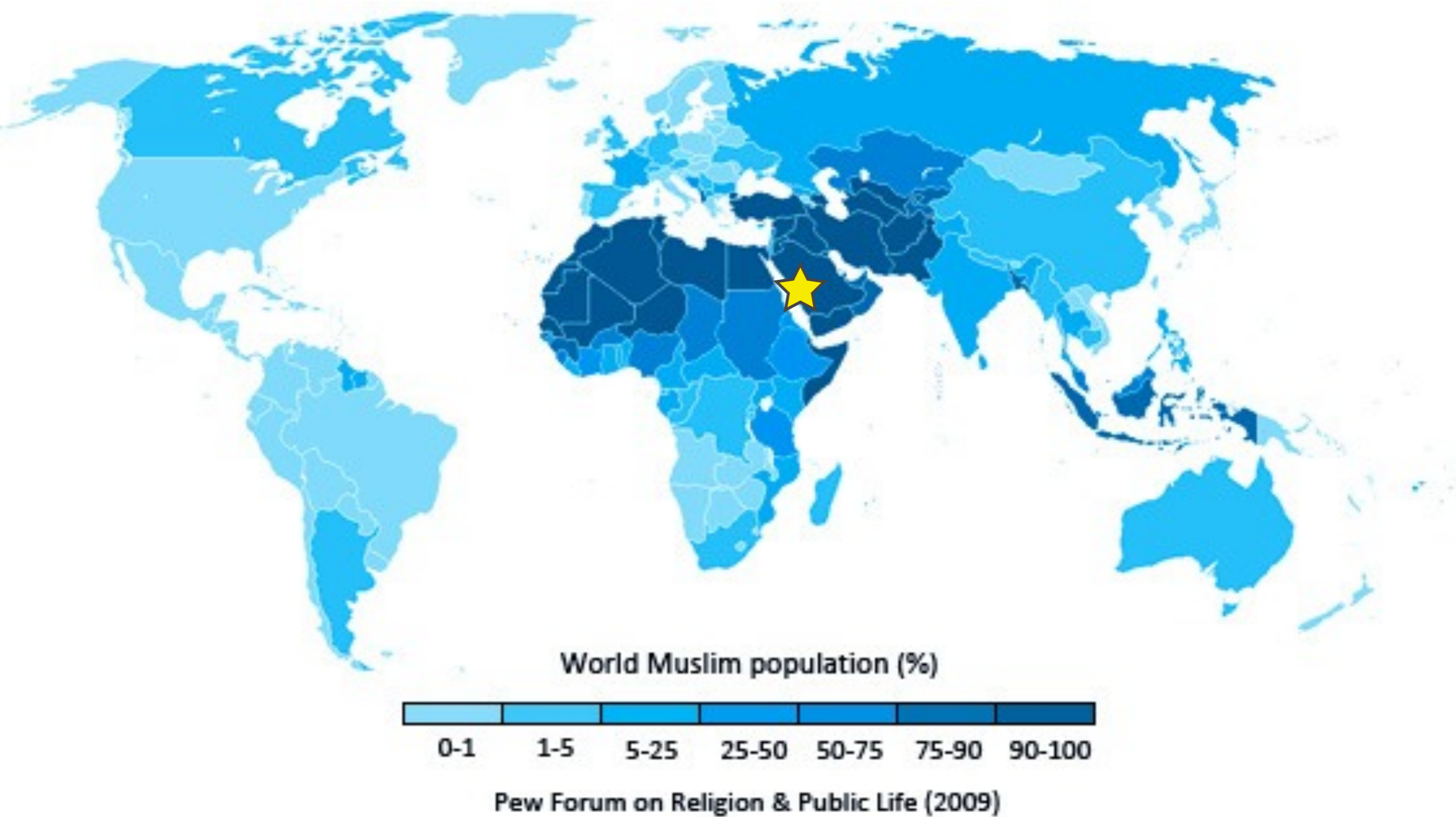

## Abraj Al Bait Complex

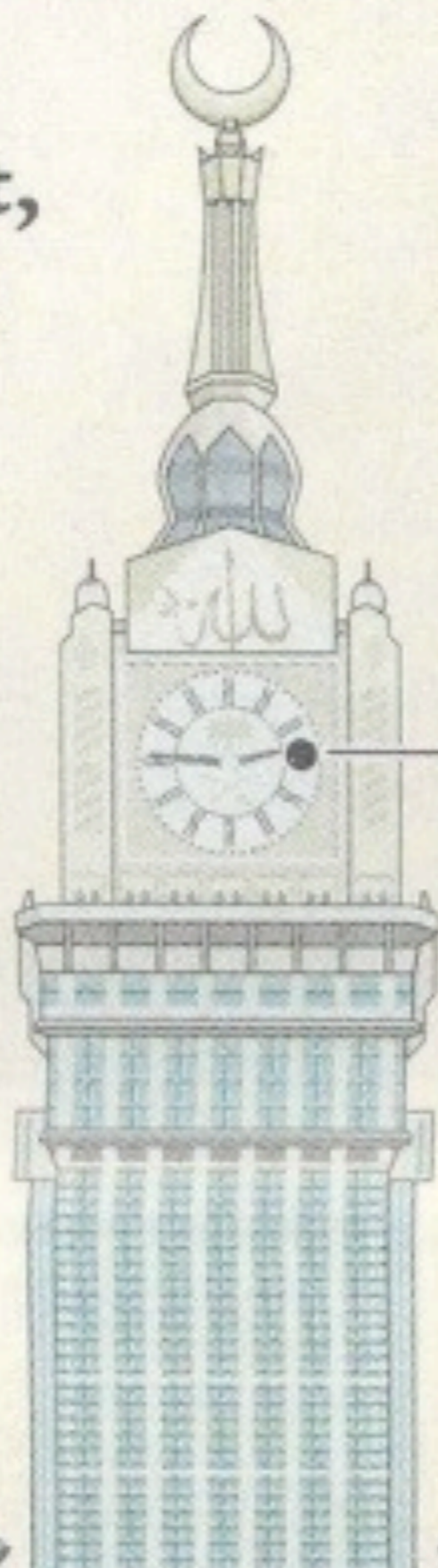

- ▶ Set to open: 3rd quarter 2010

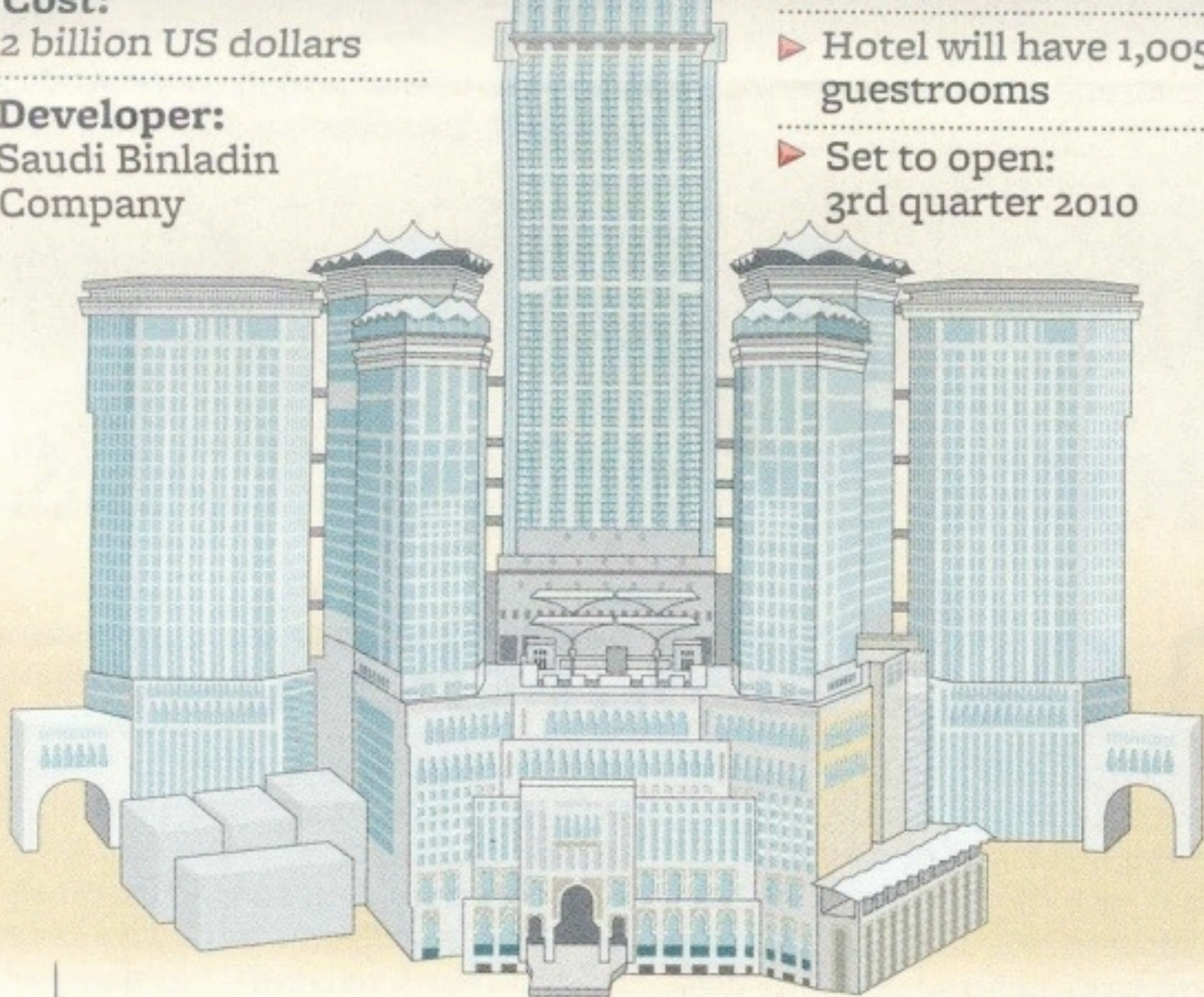


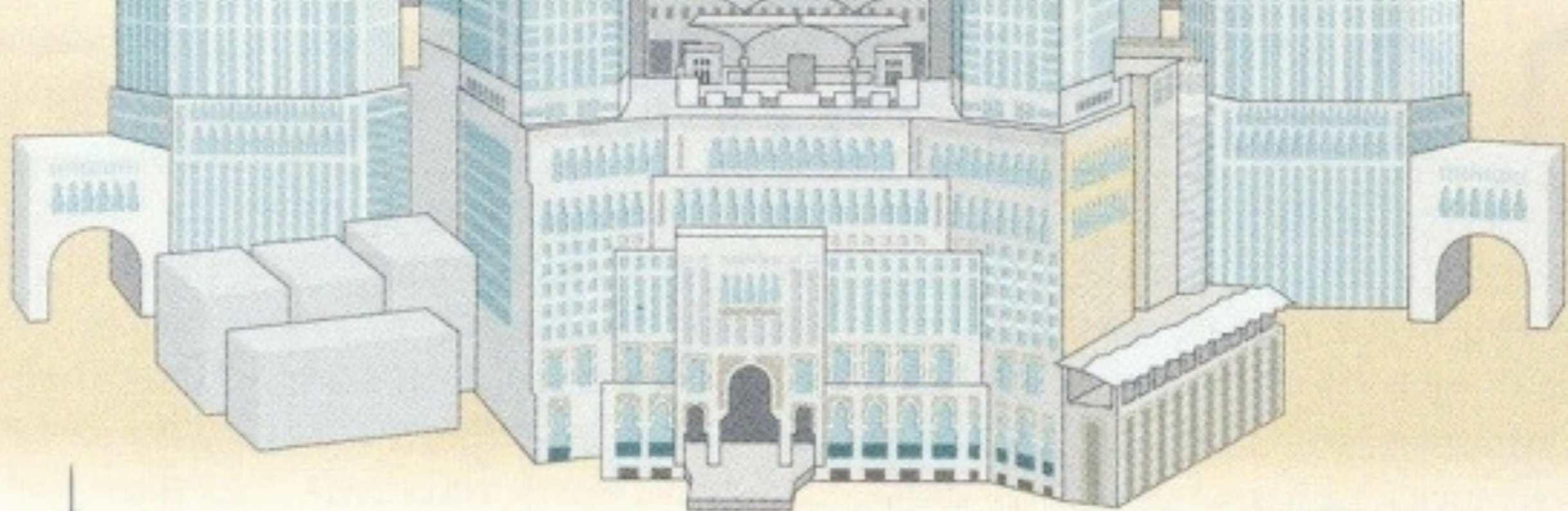
