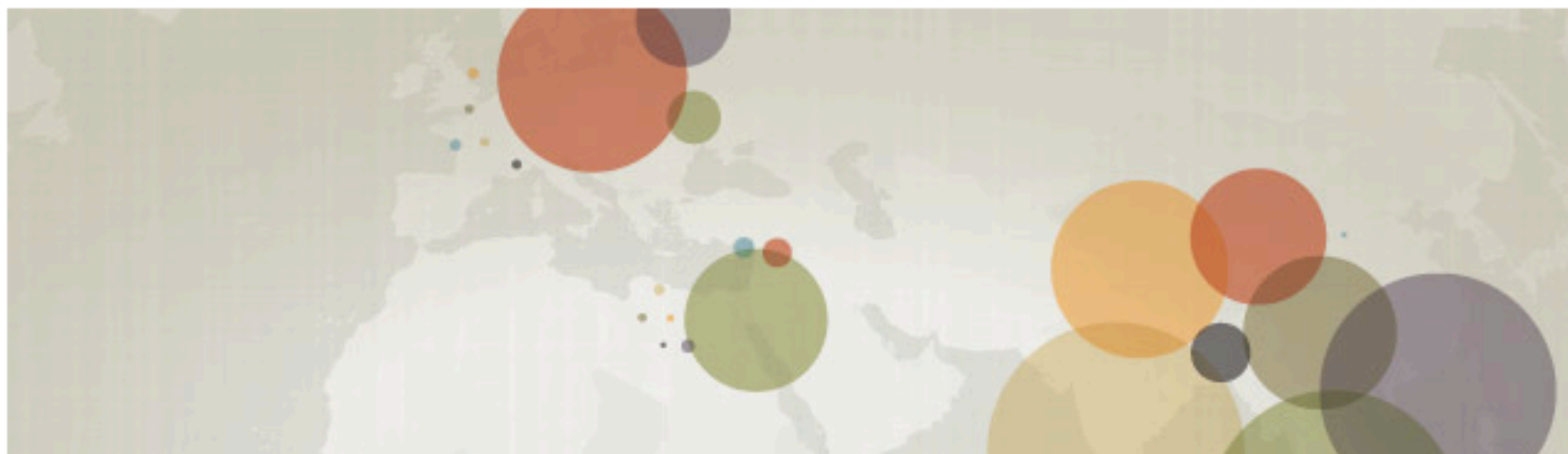

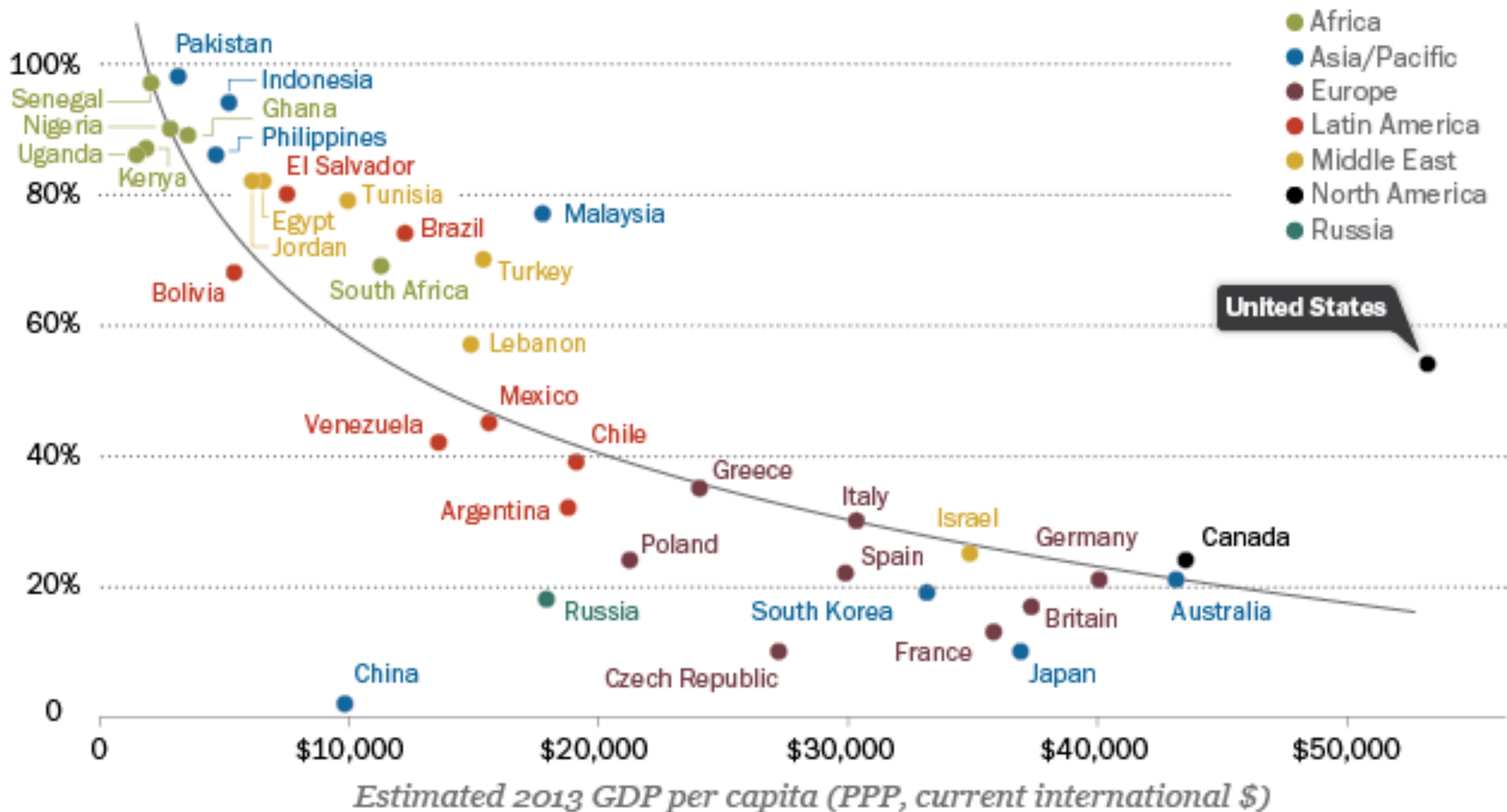

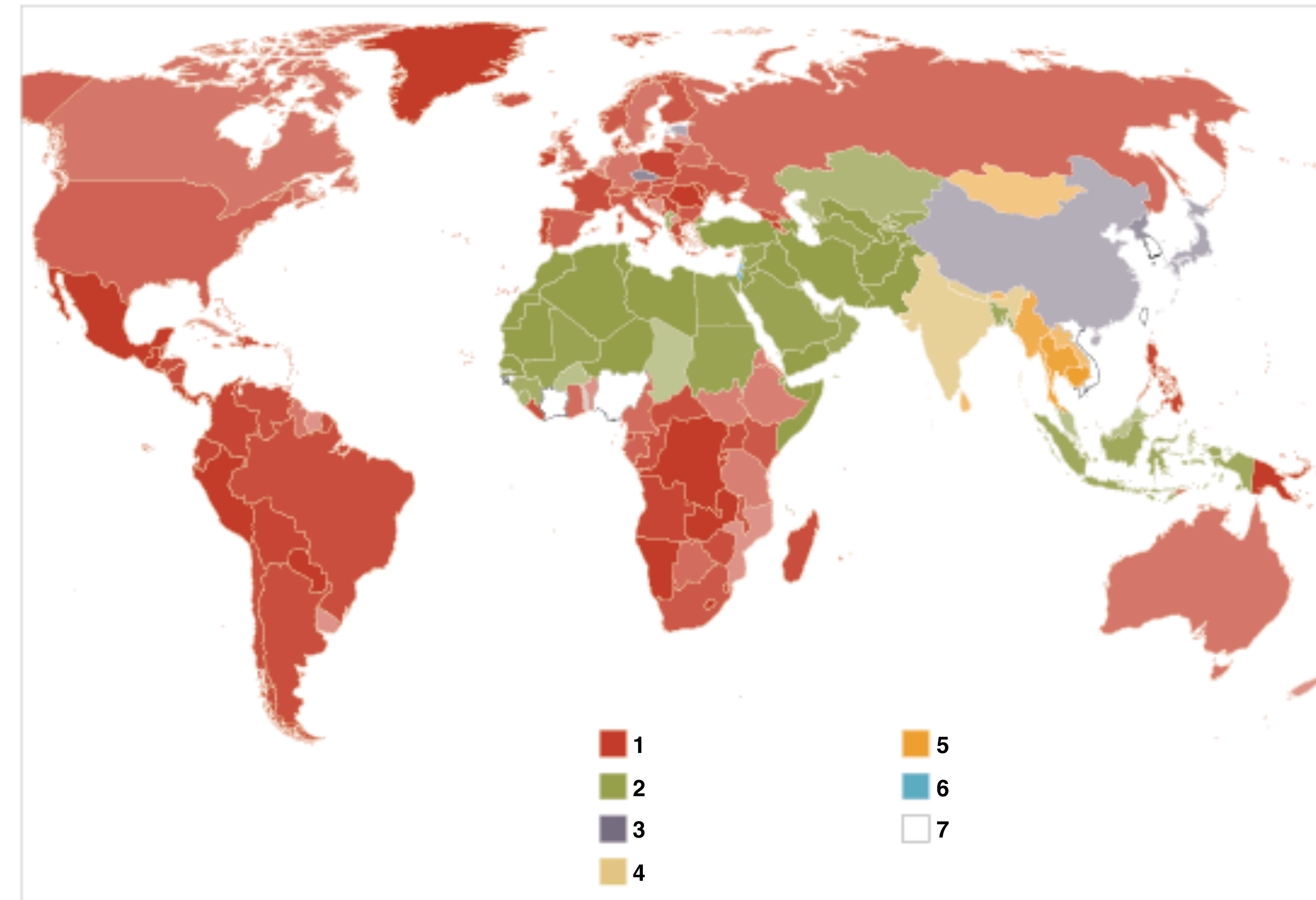
% saying religion plays a very important role in their lives (2011-2013)

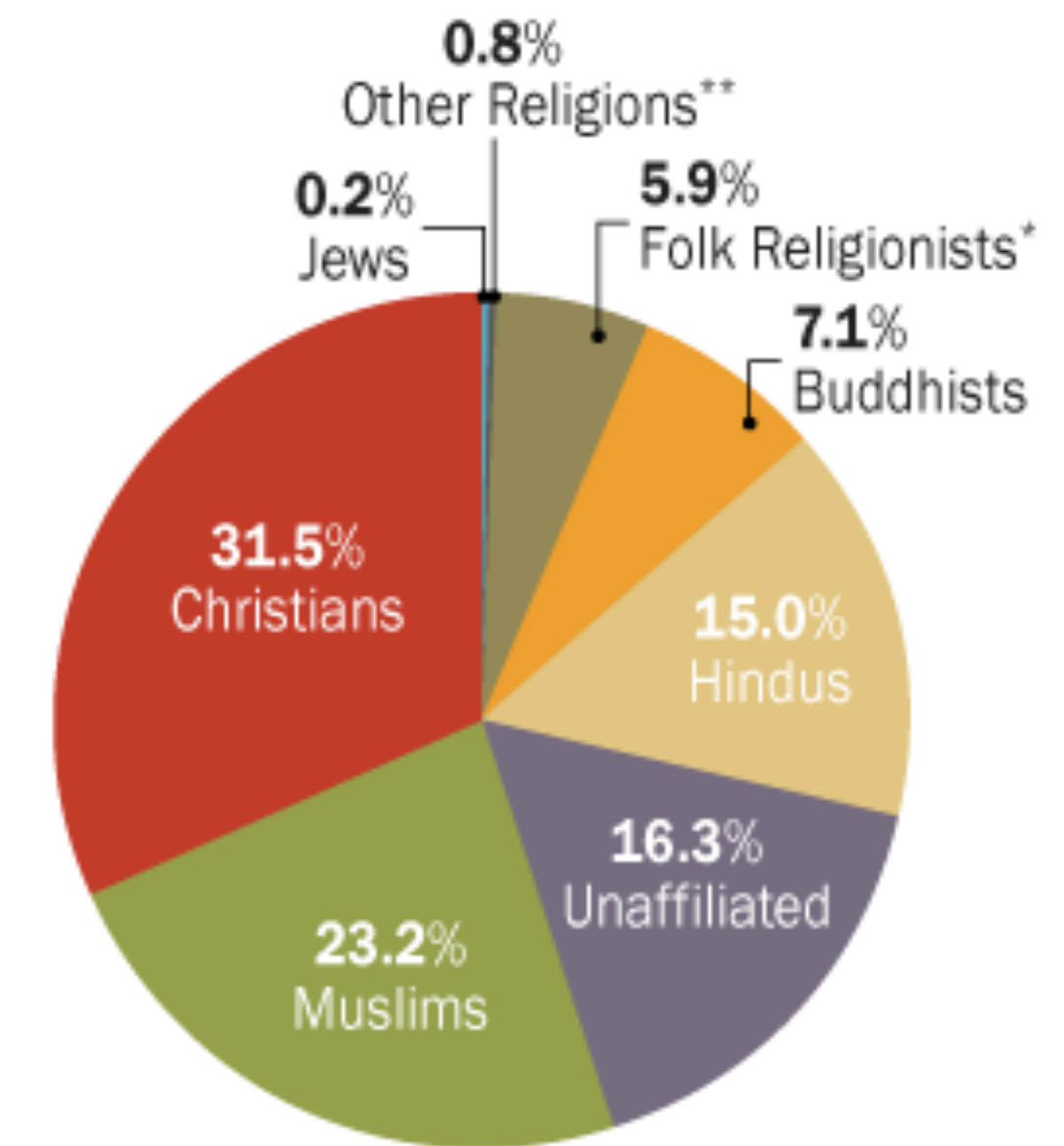

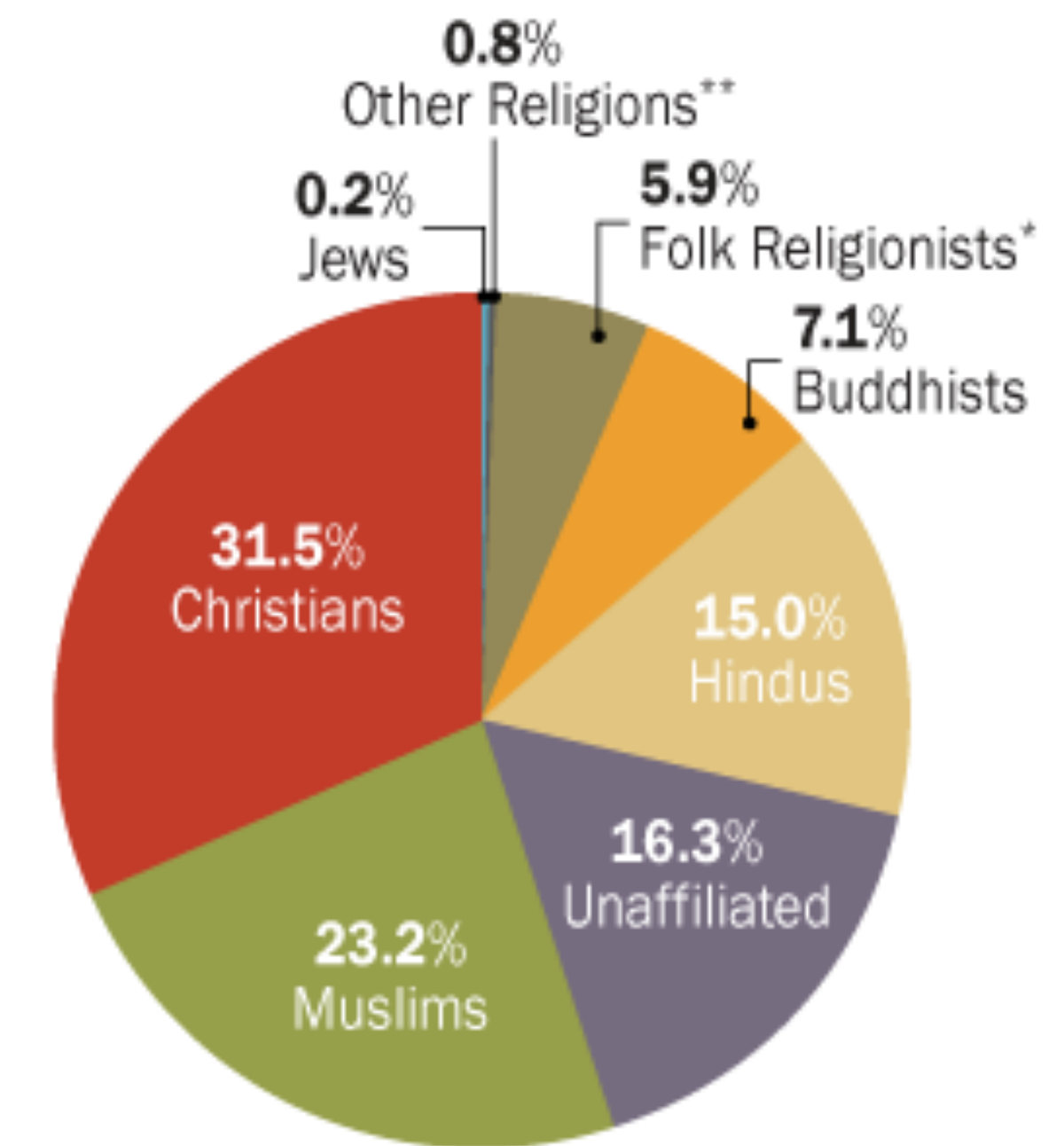

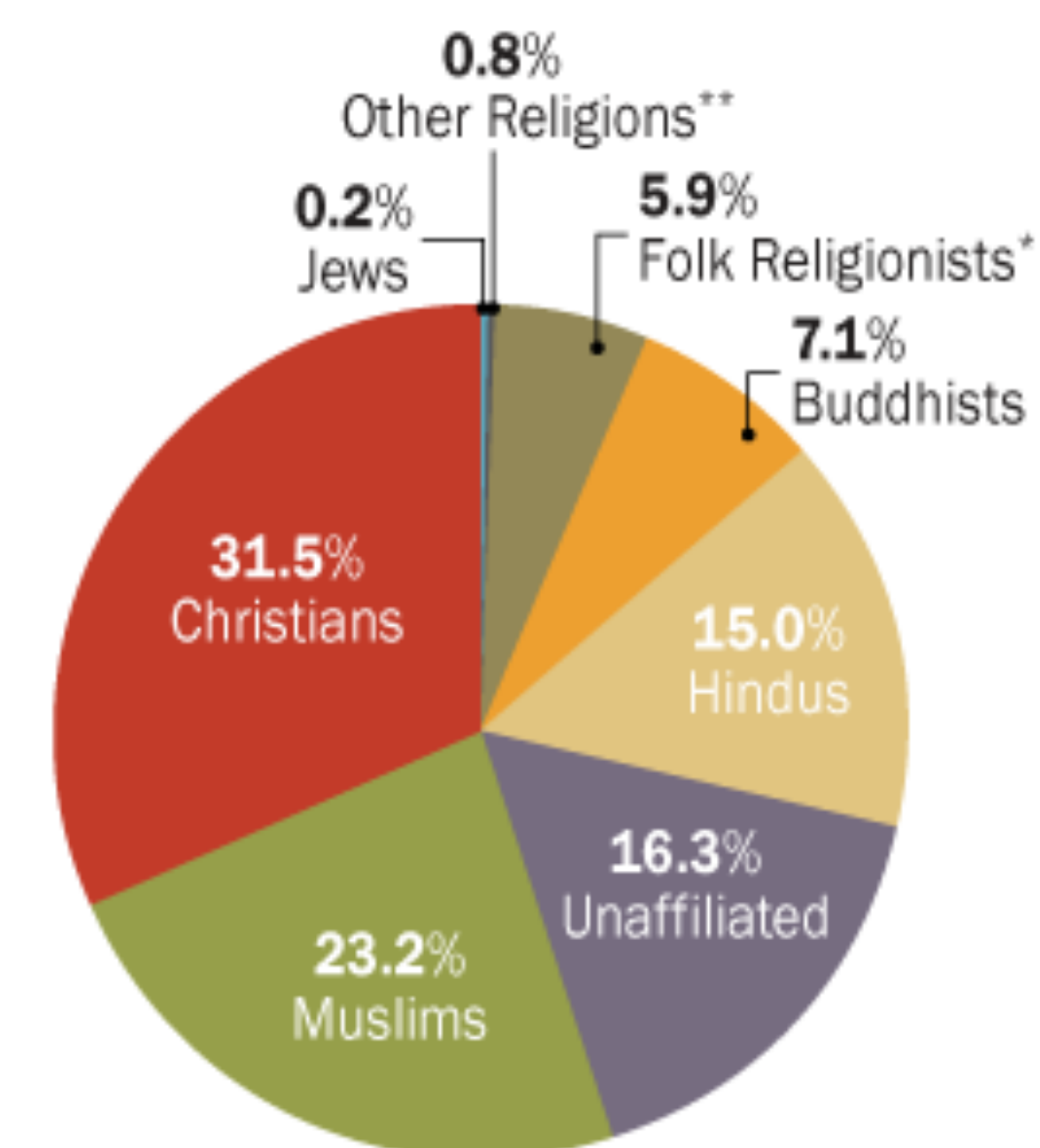

Percentage of the global population



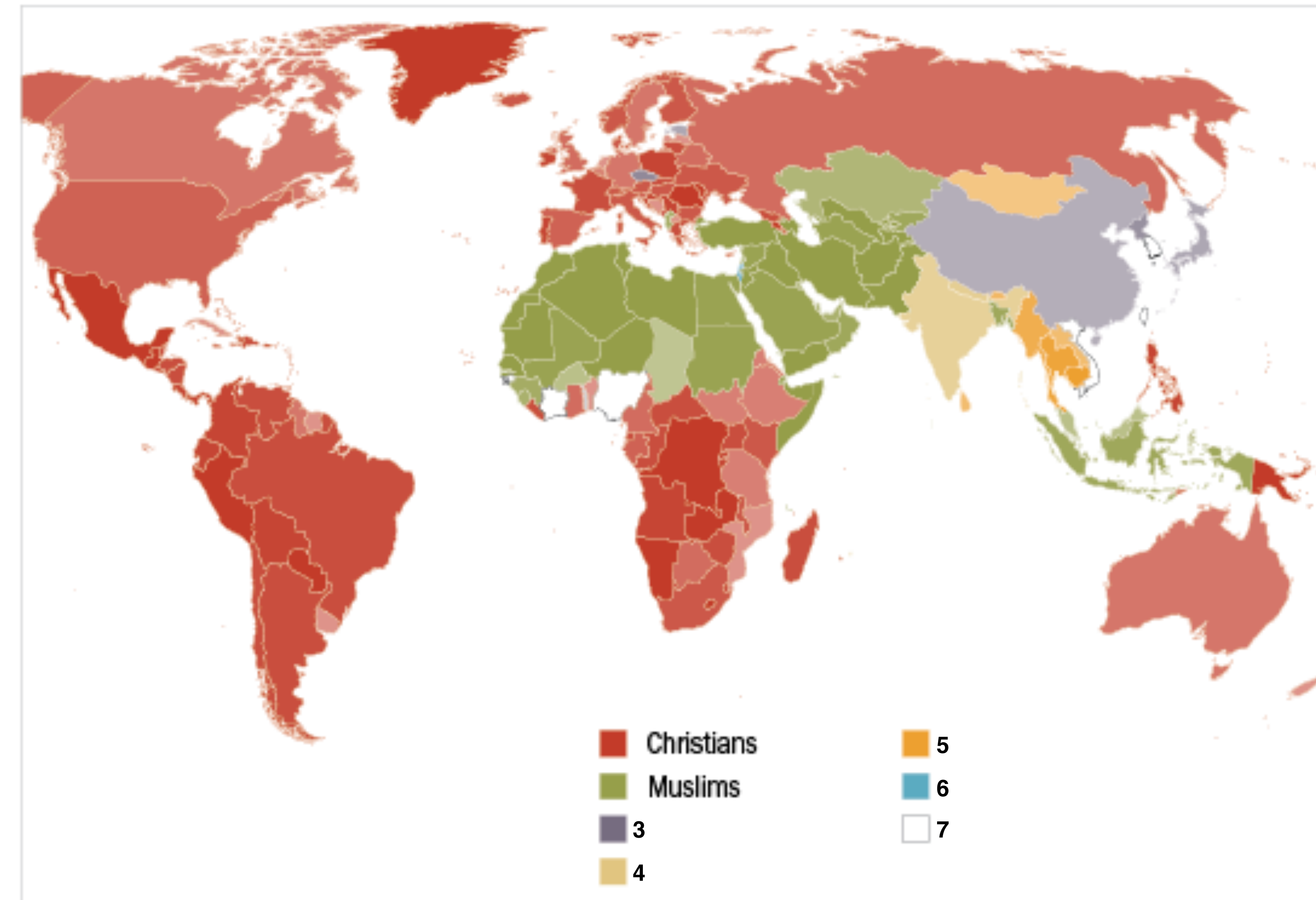

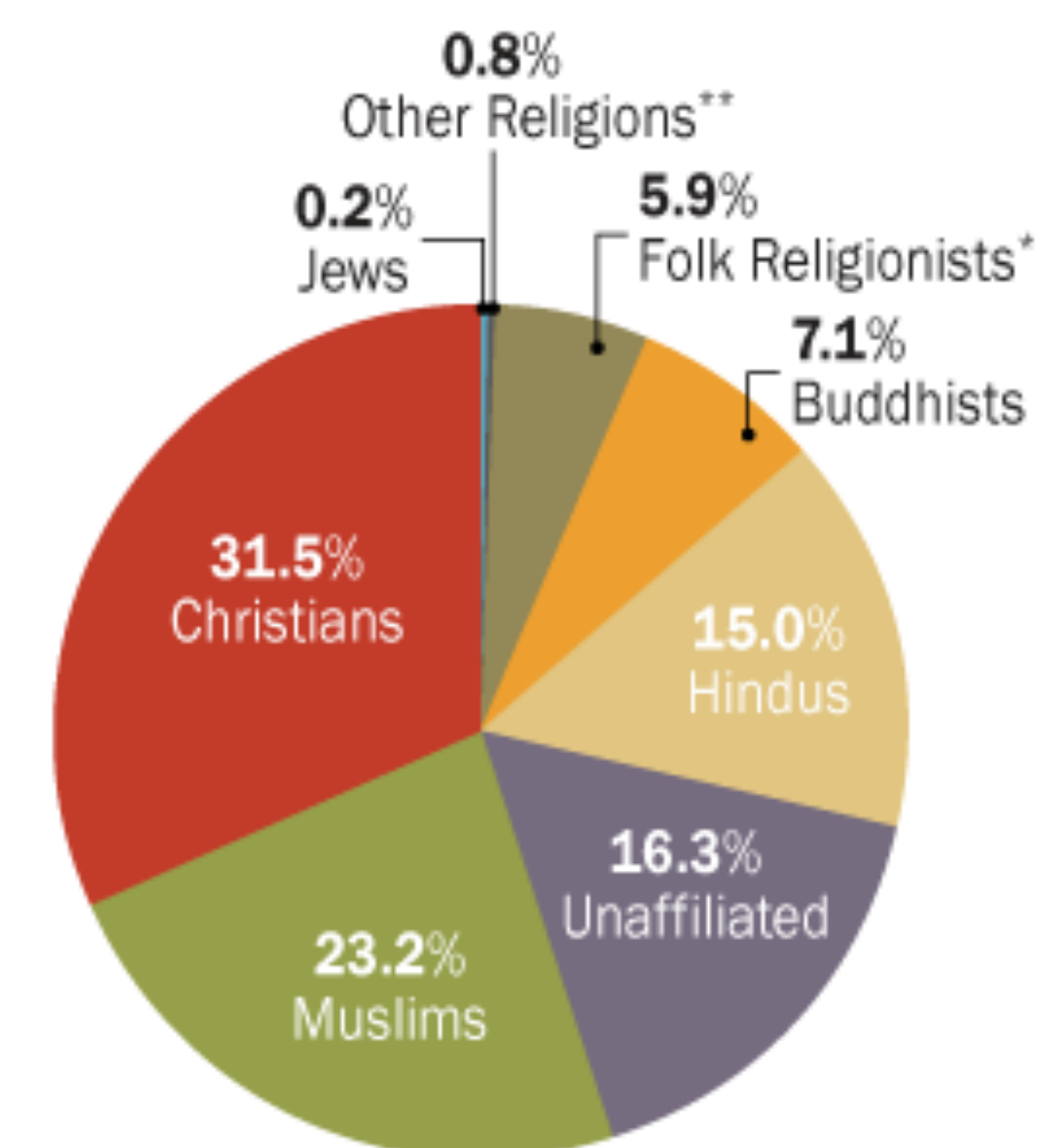

Percentage of the global population



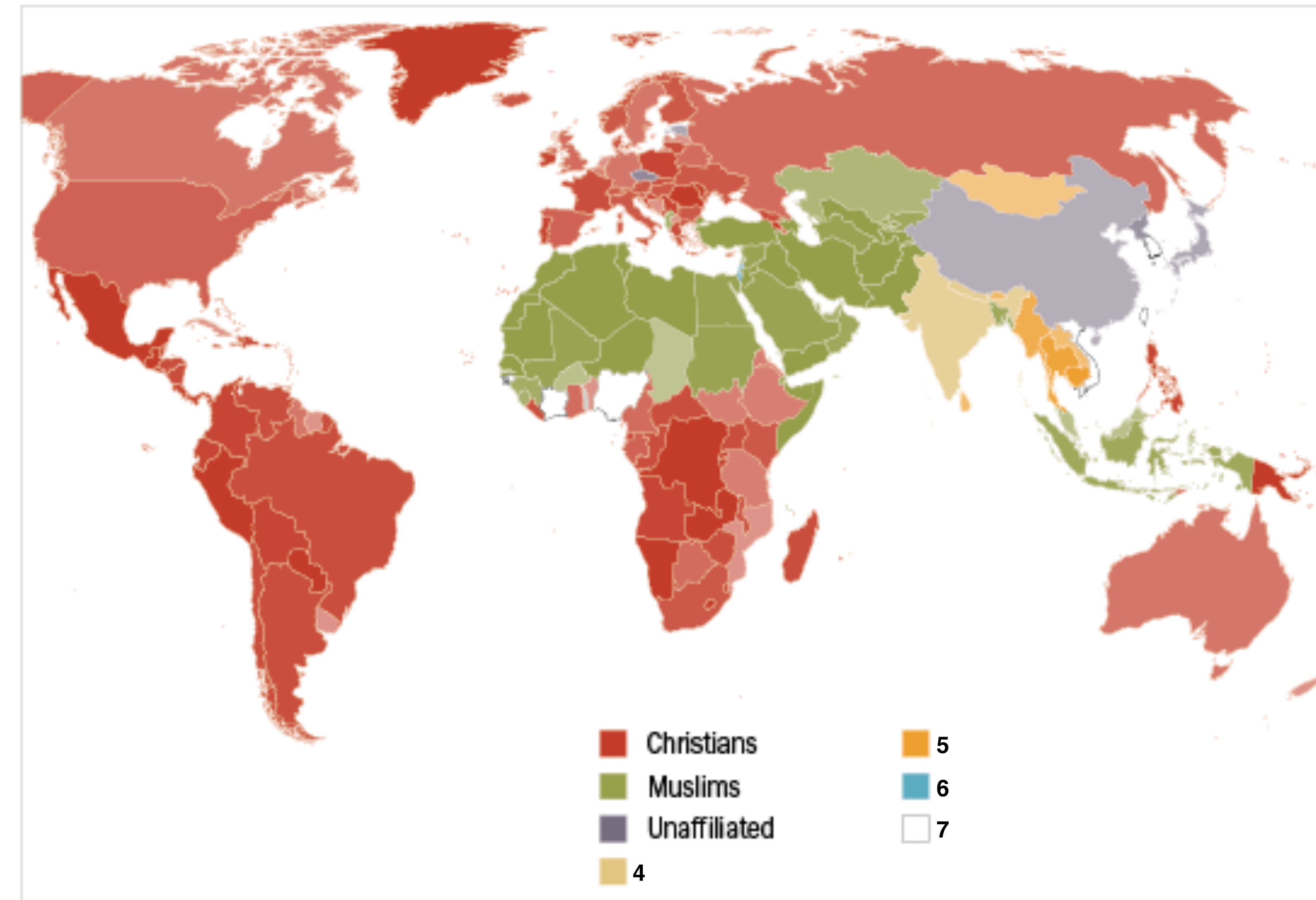

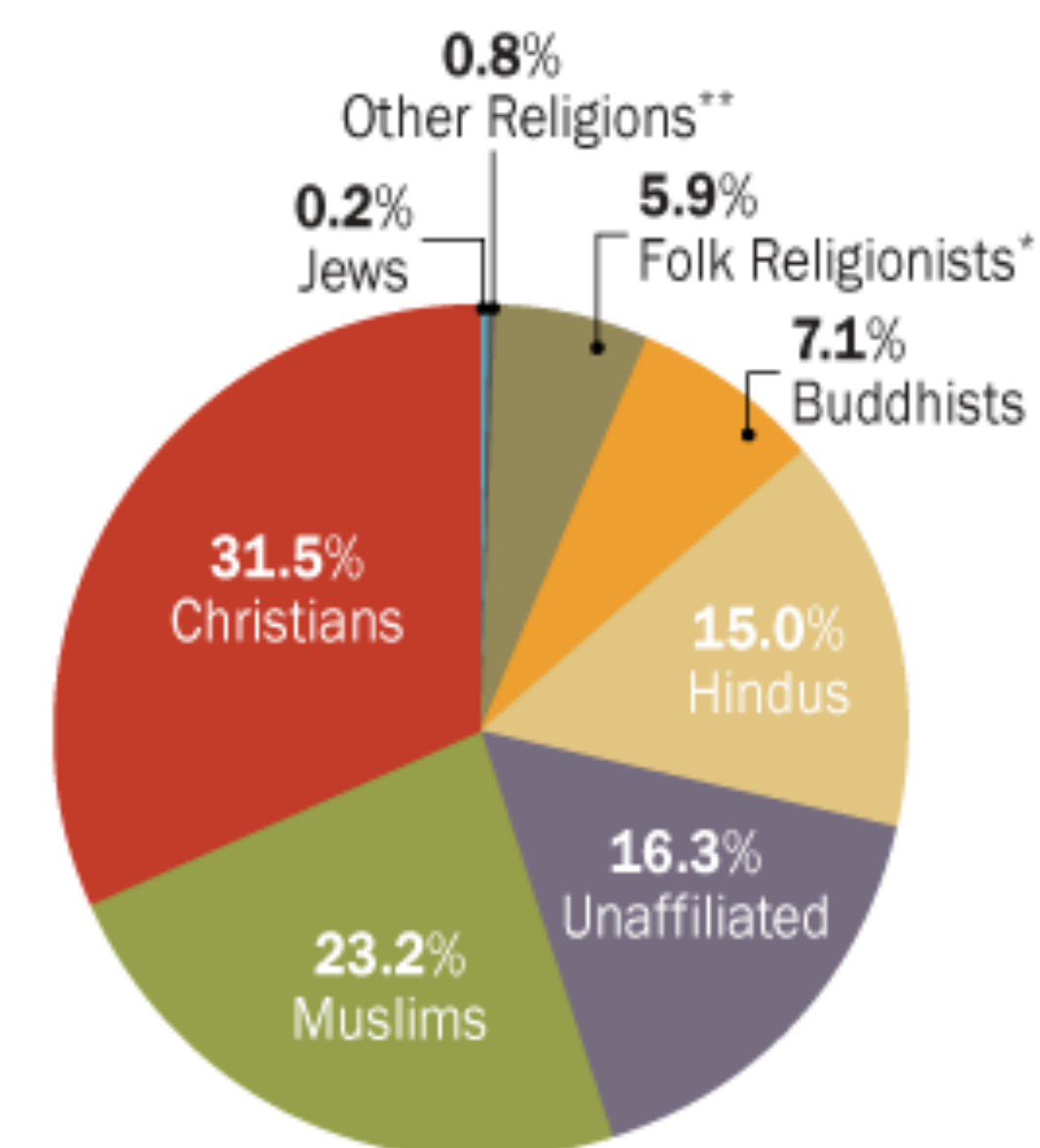

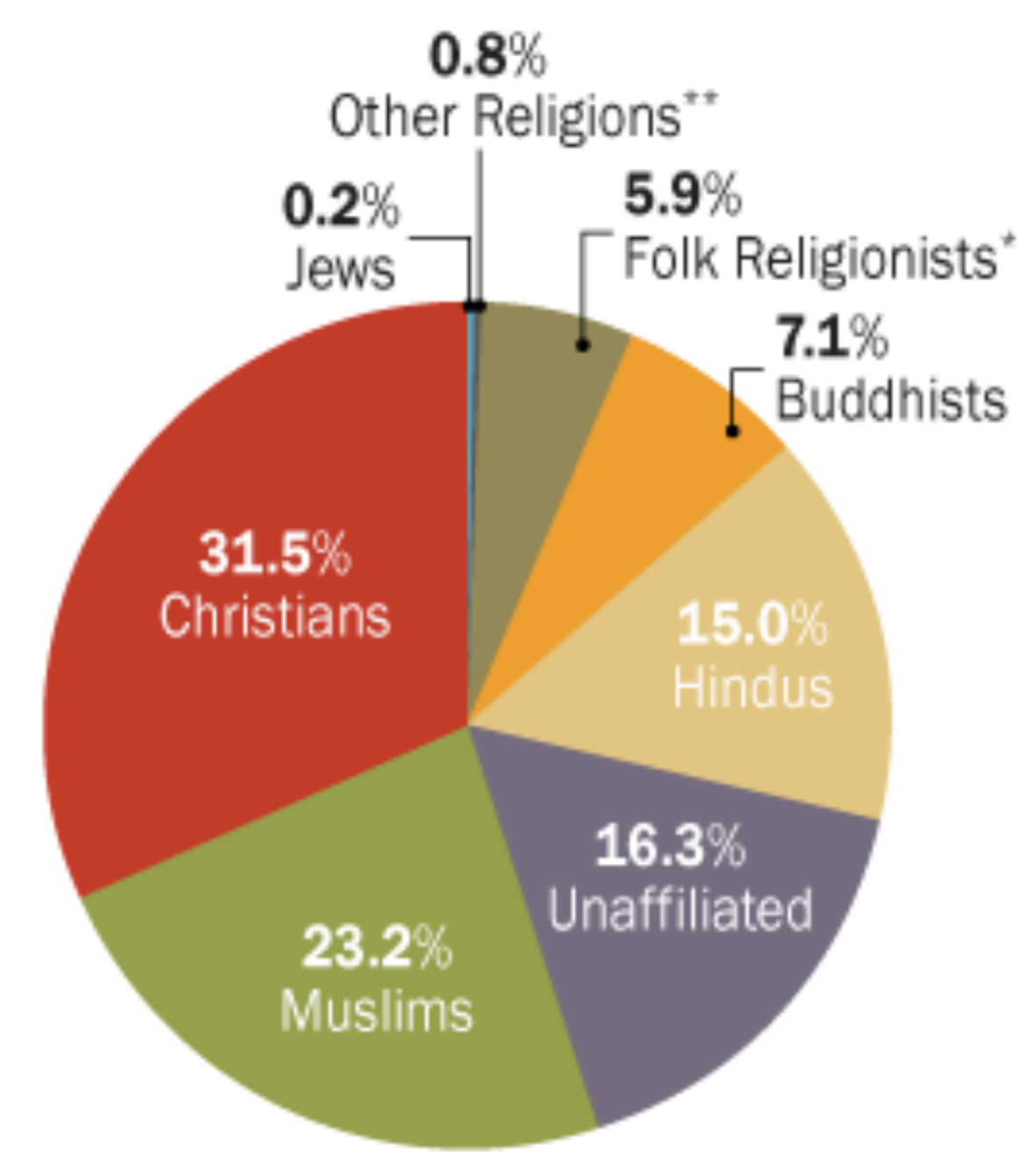

Size of Major Religious Groups, 2010

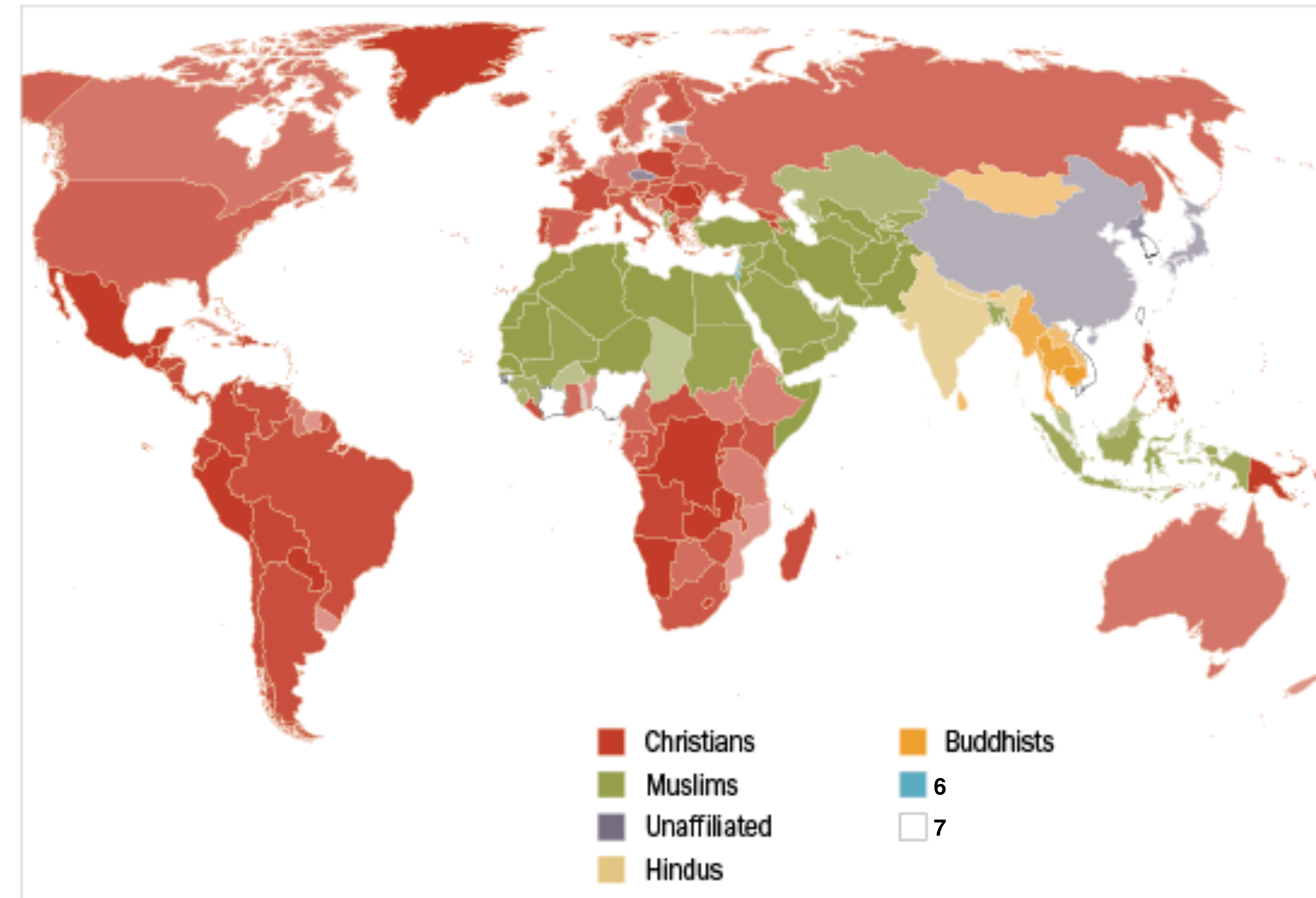

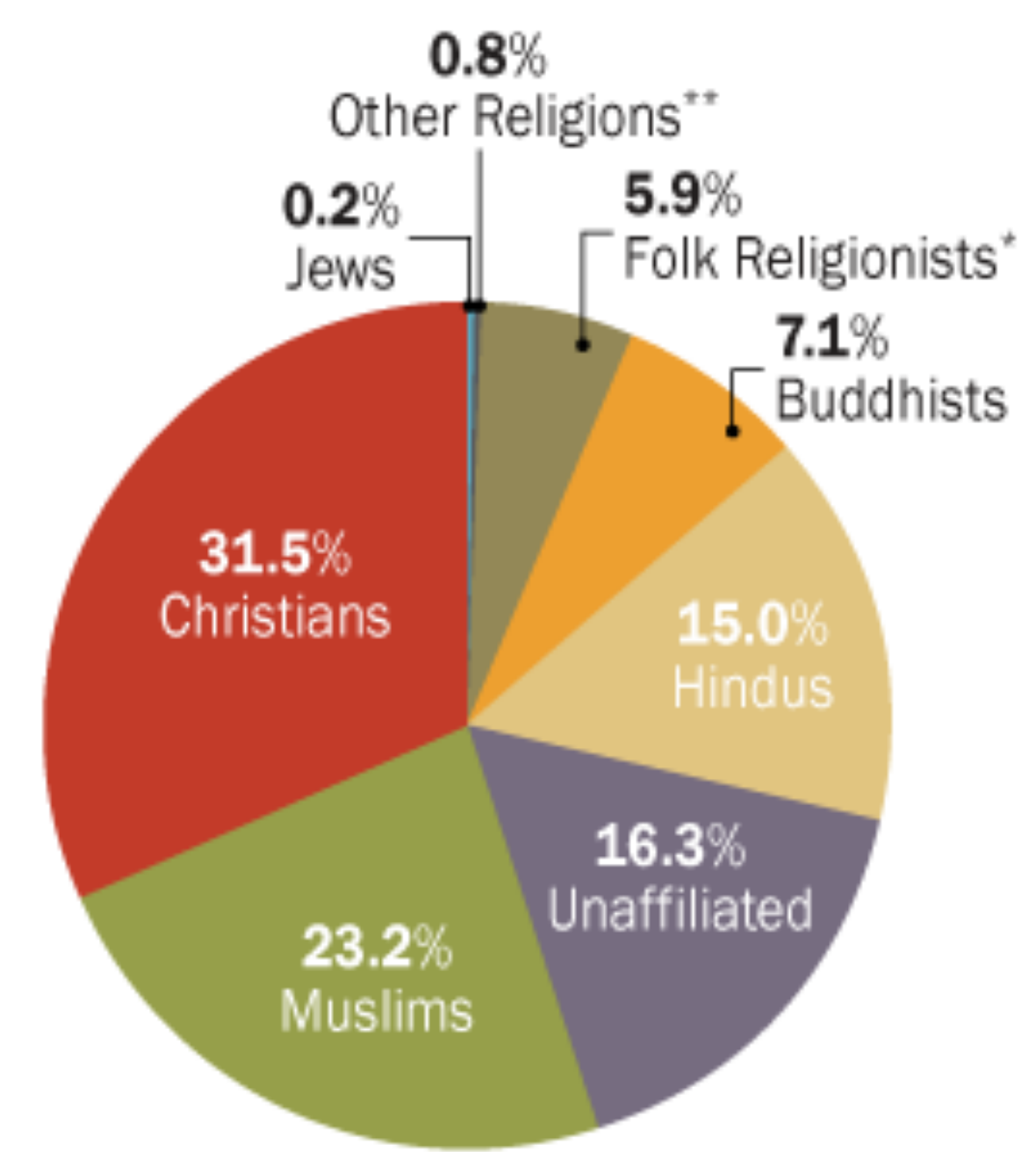

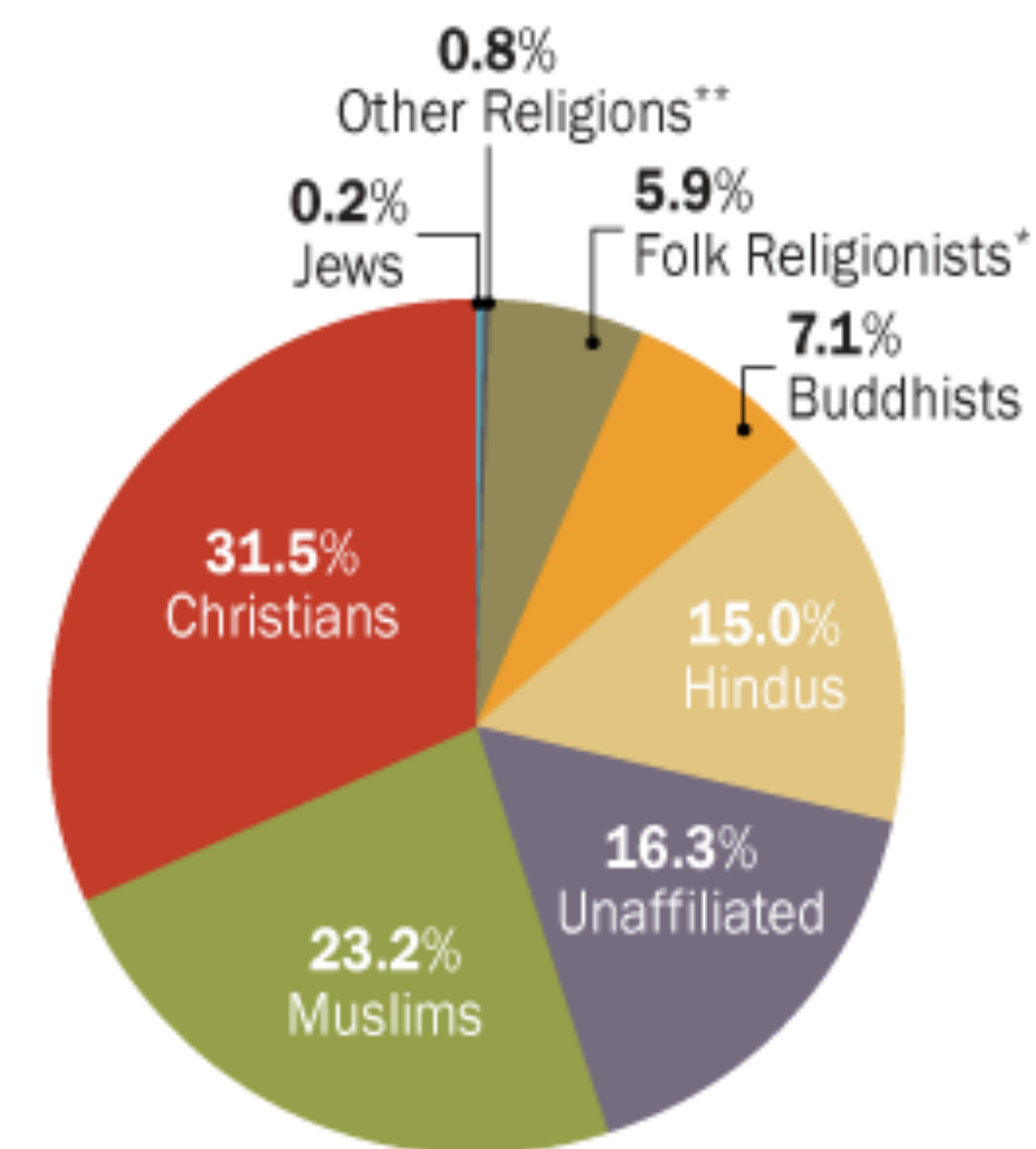

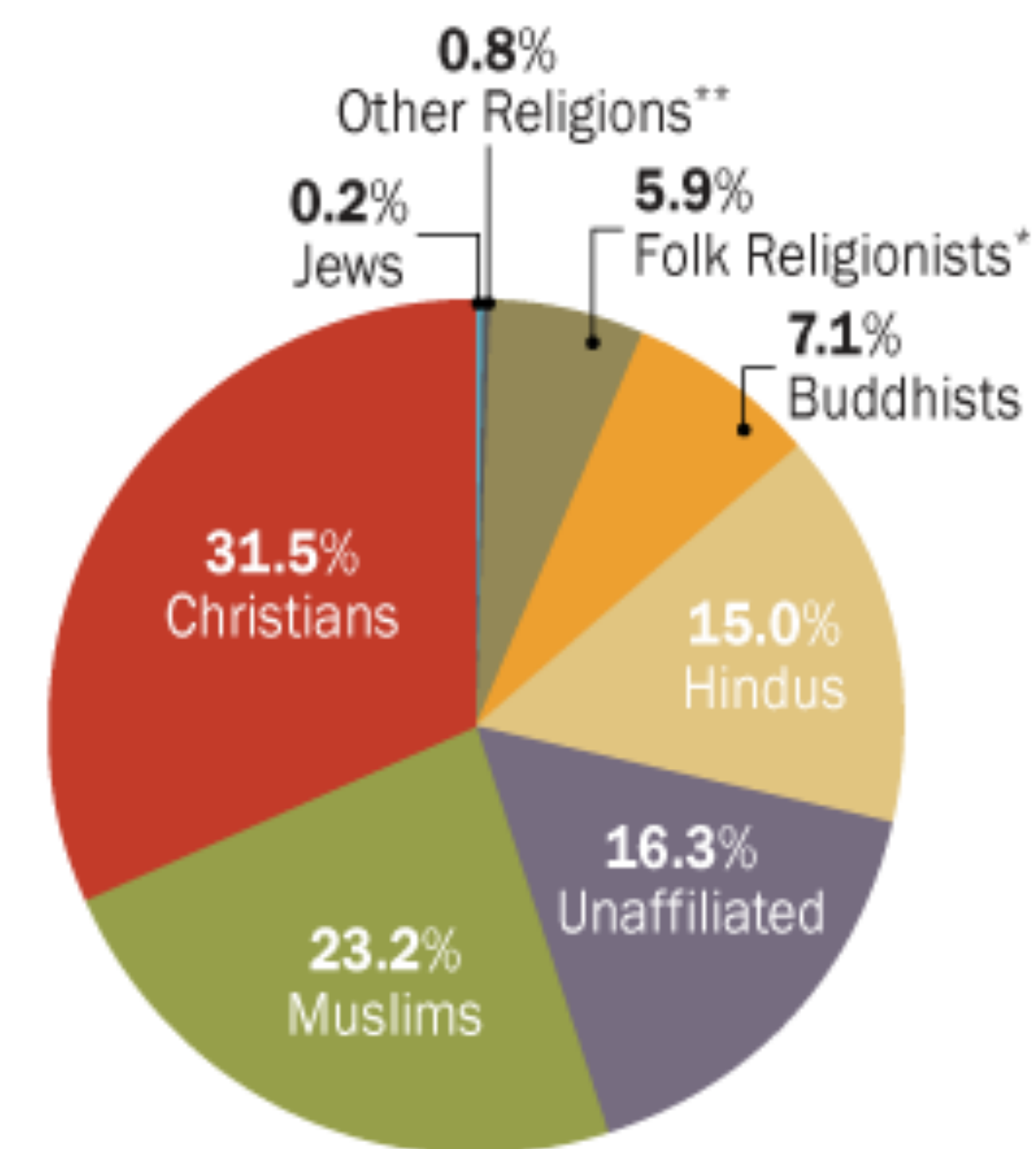

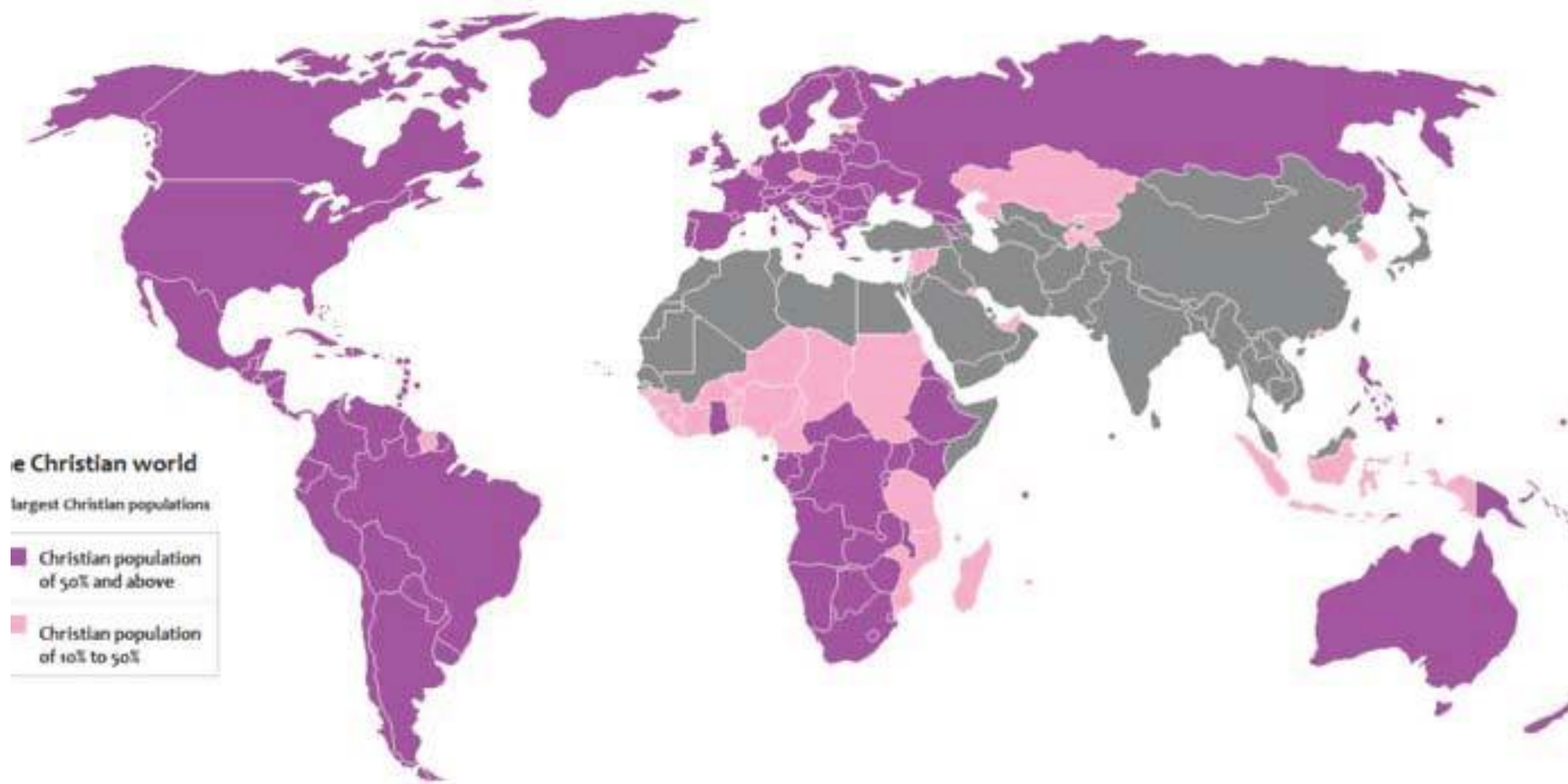
