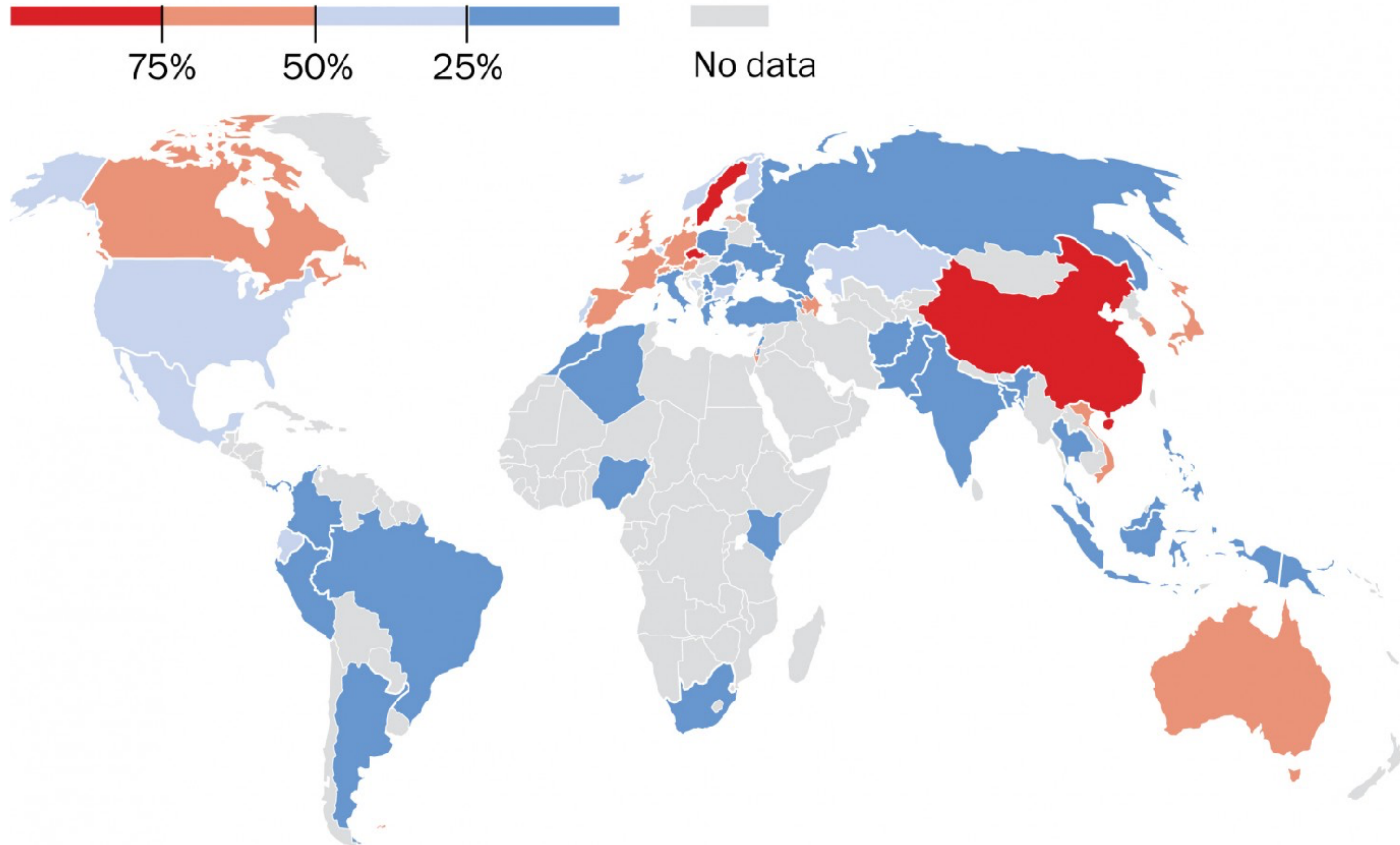

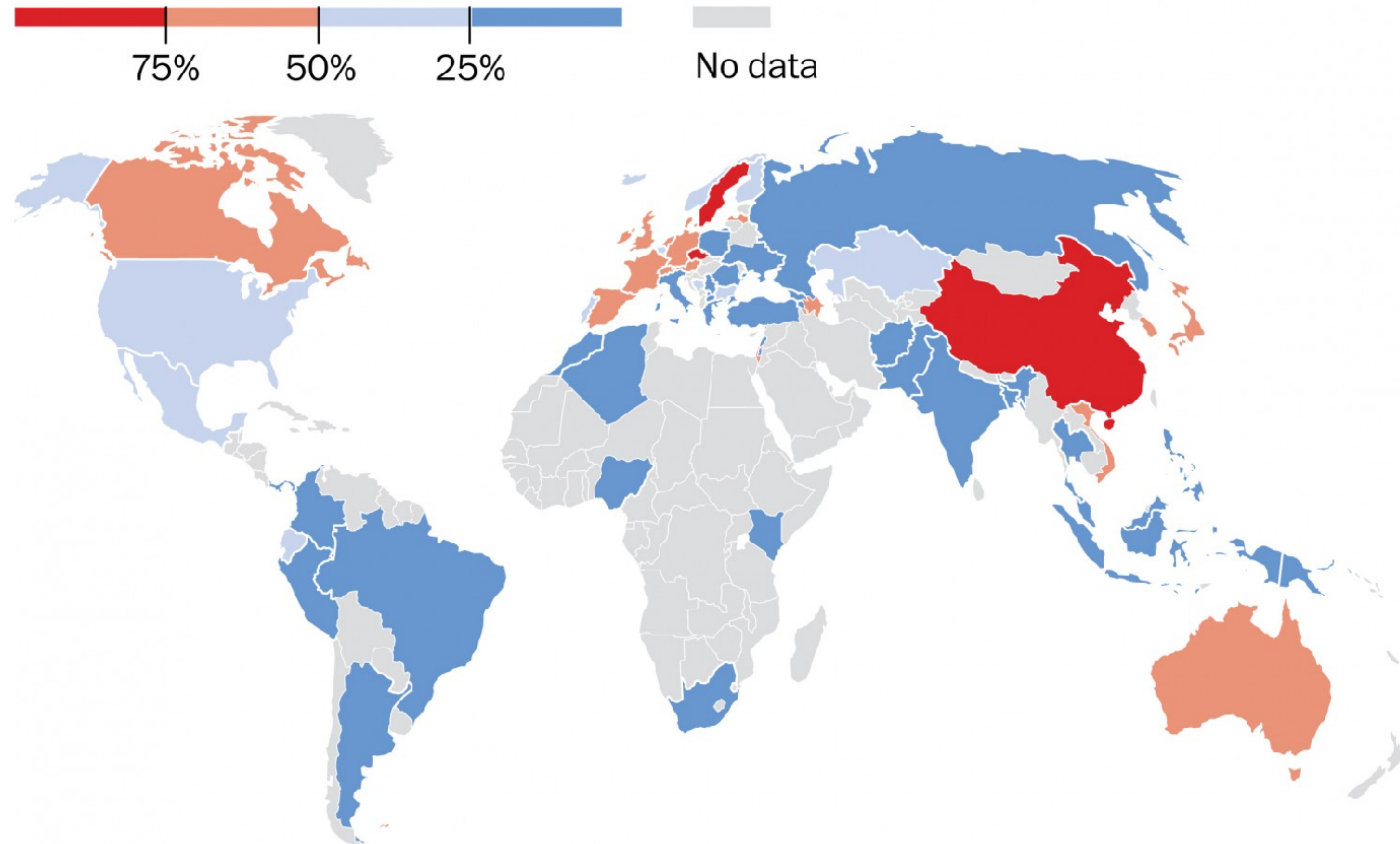

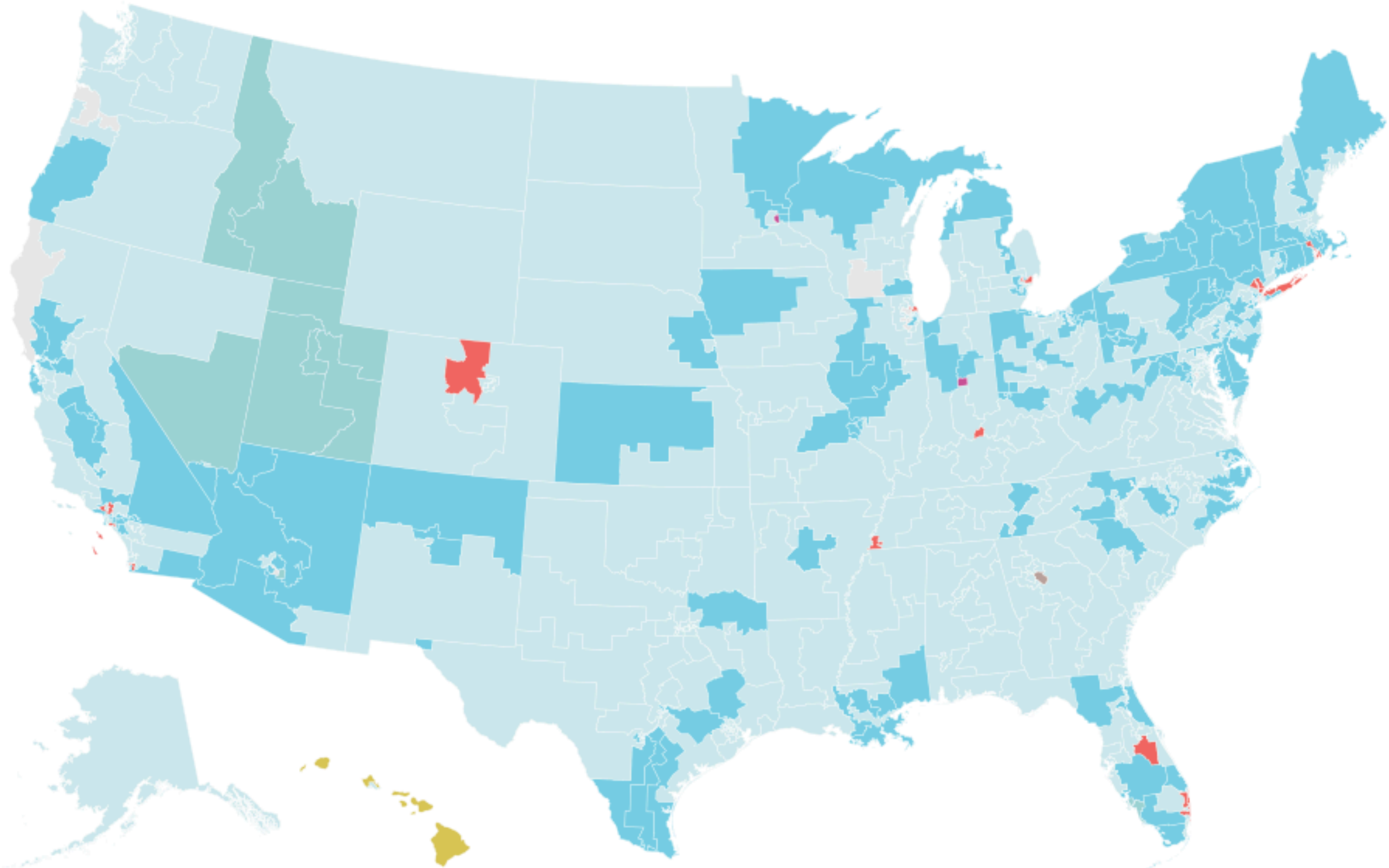

Percentage of respondents in each country claiming to be either not religious or atheist.

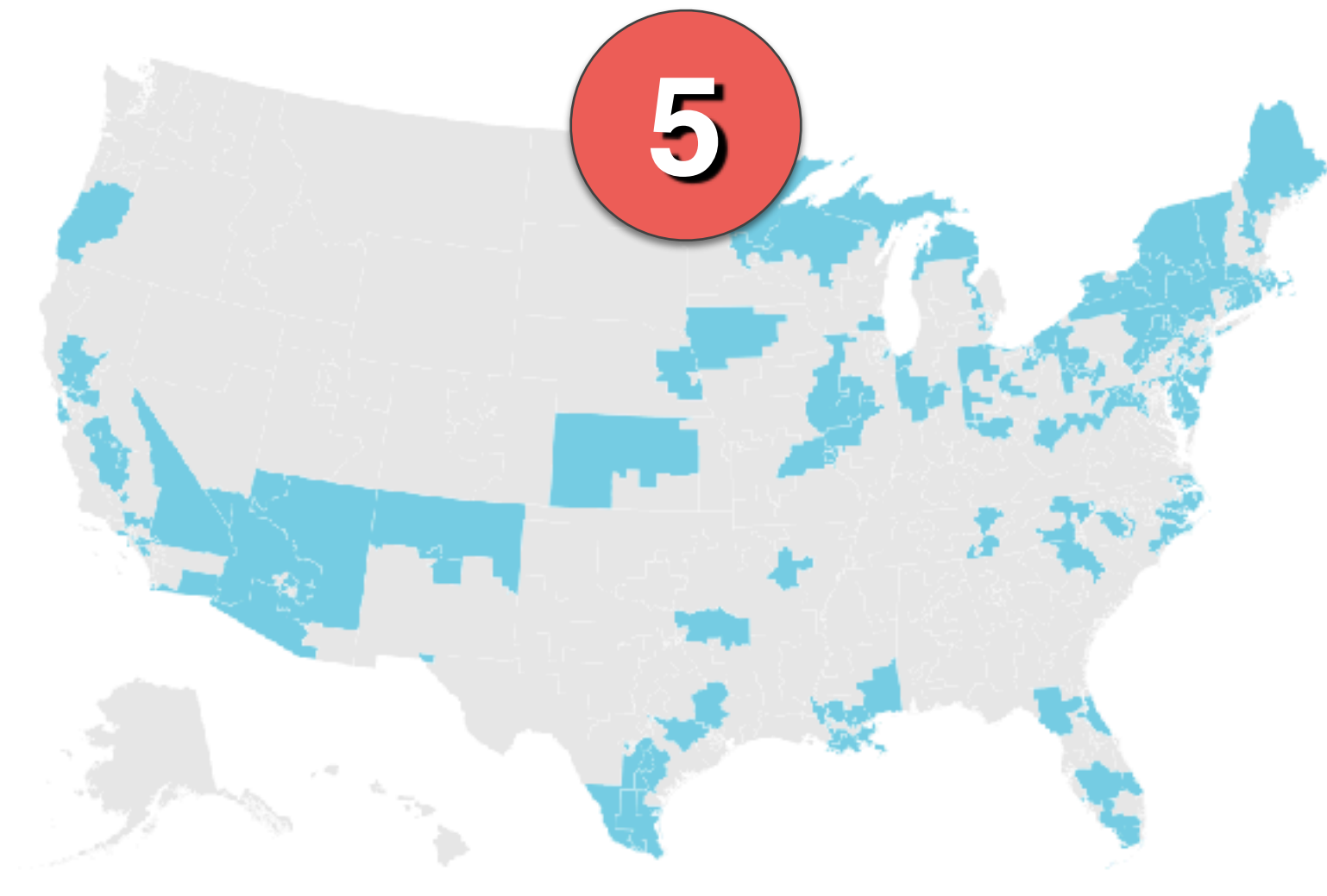
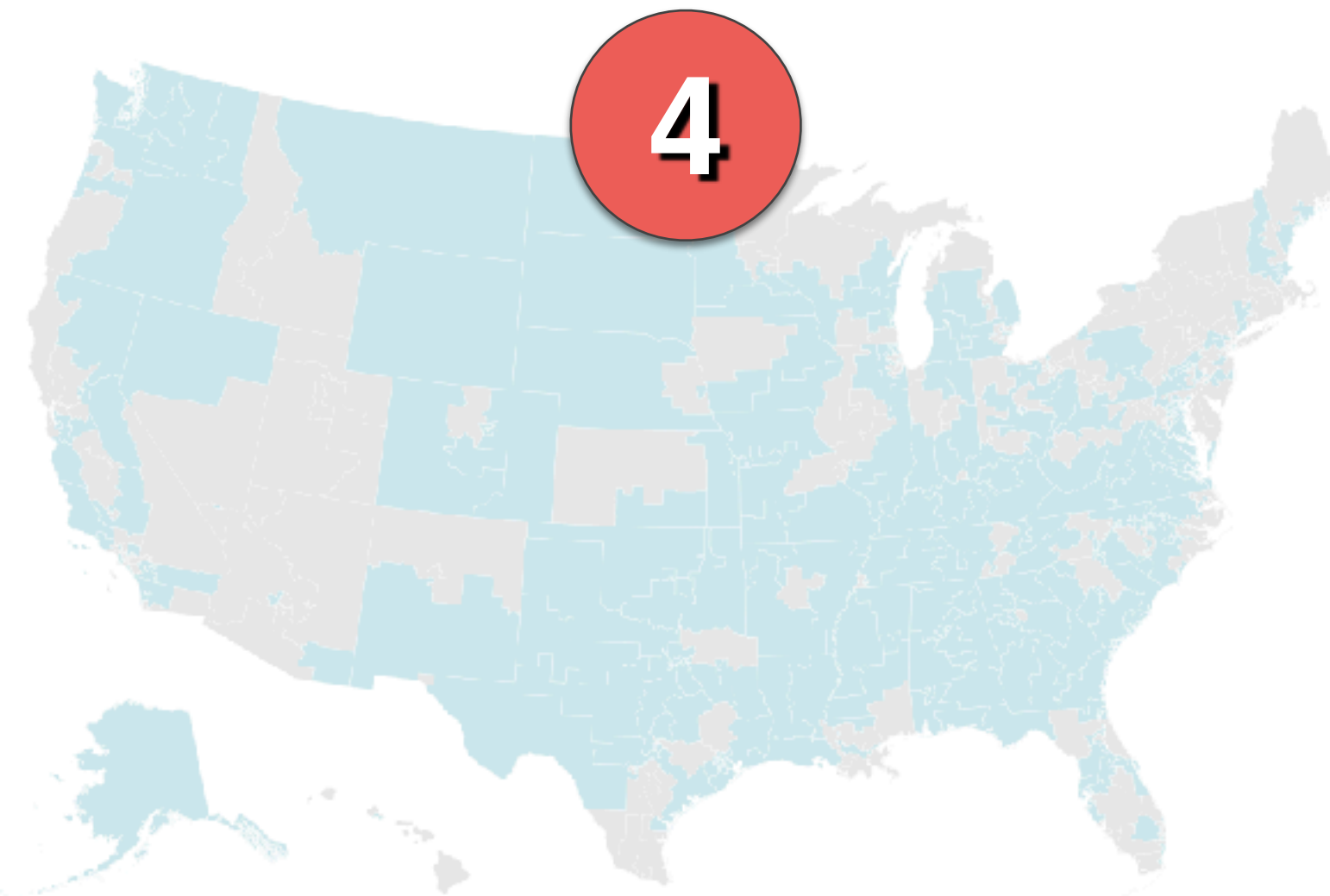
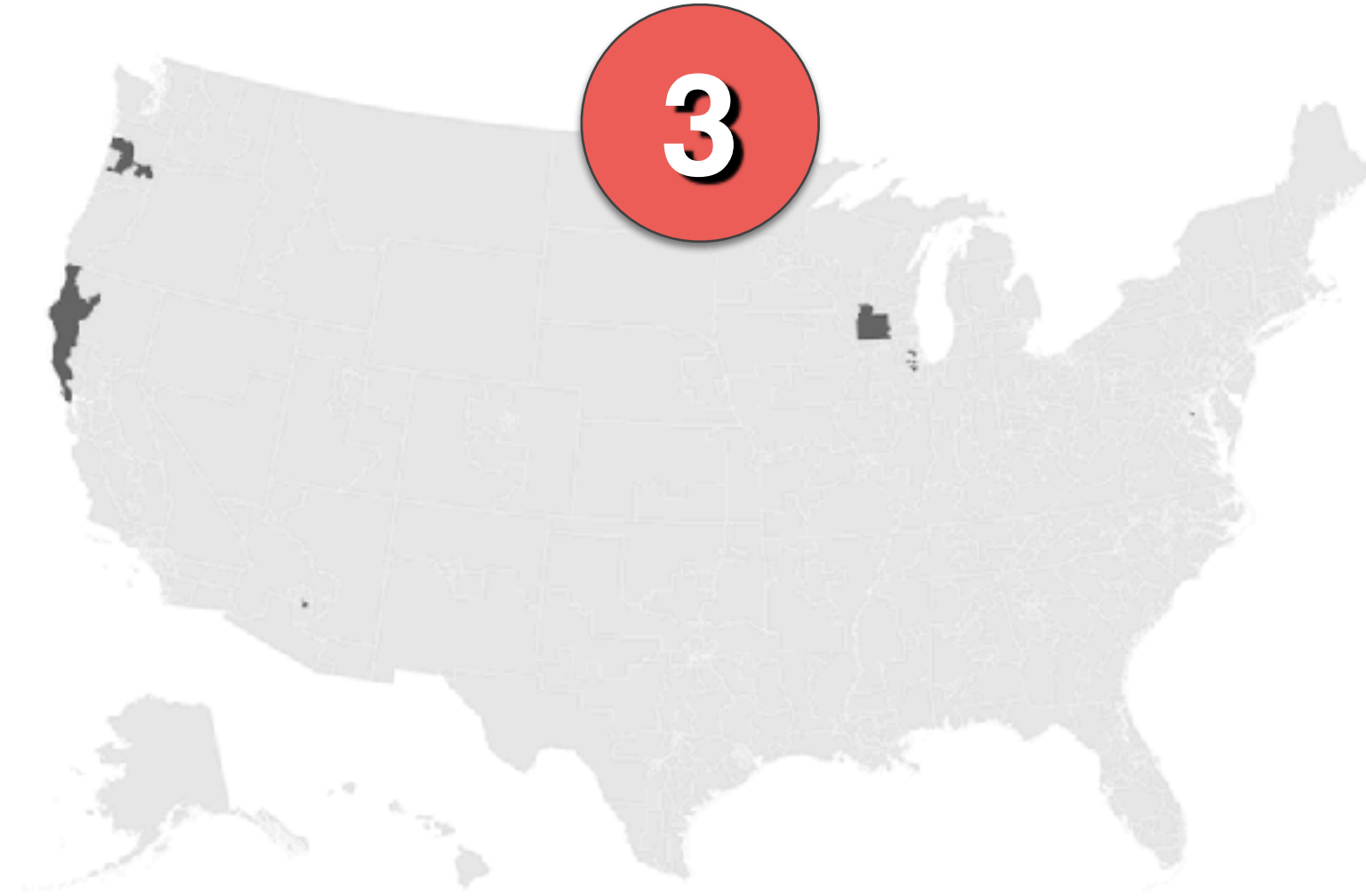
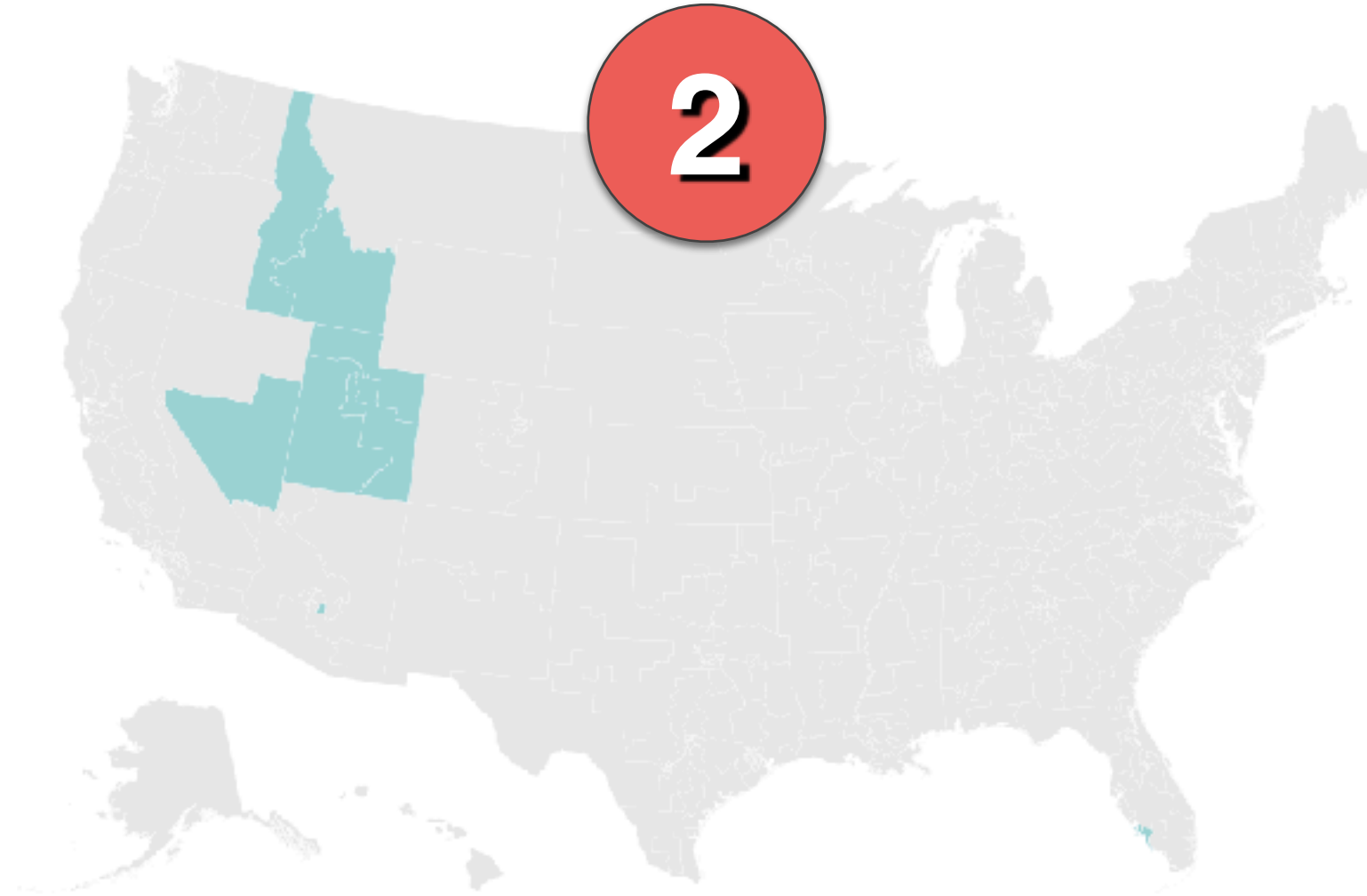
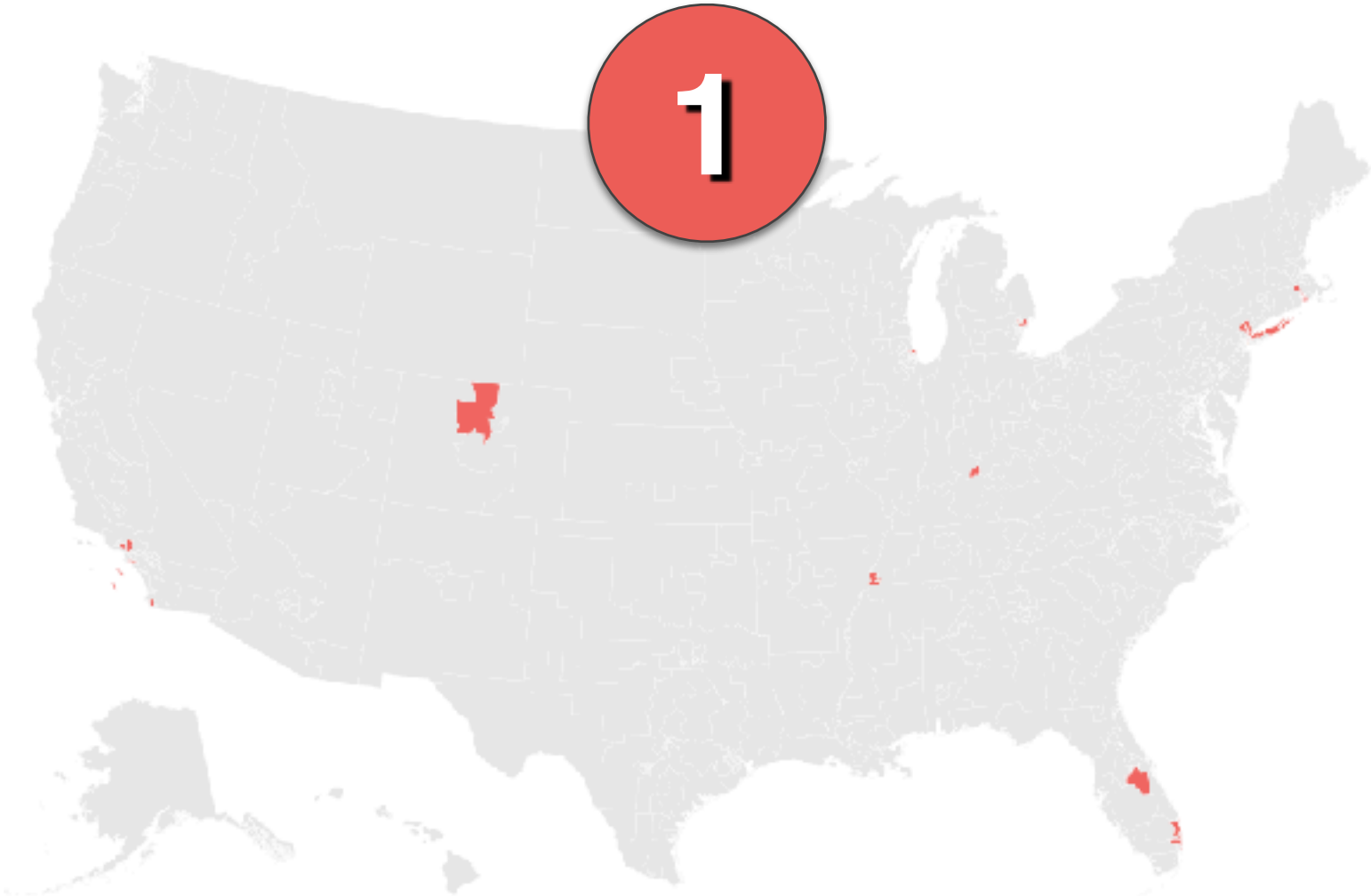

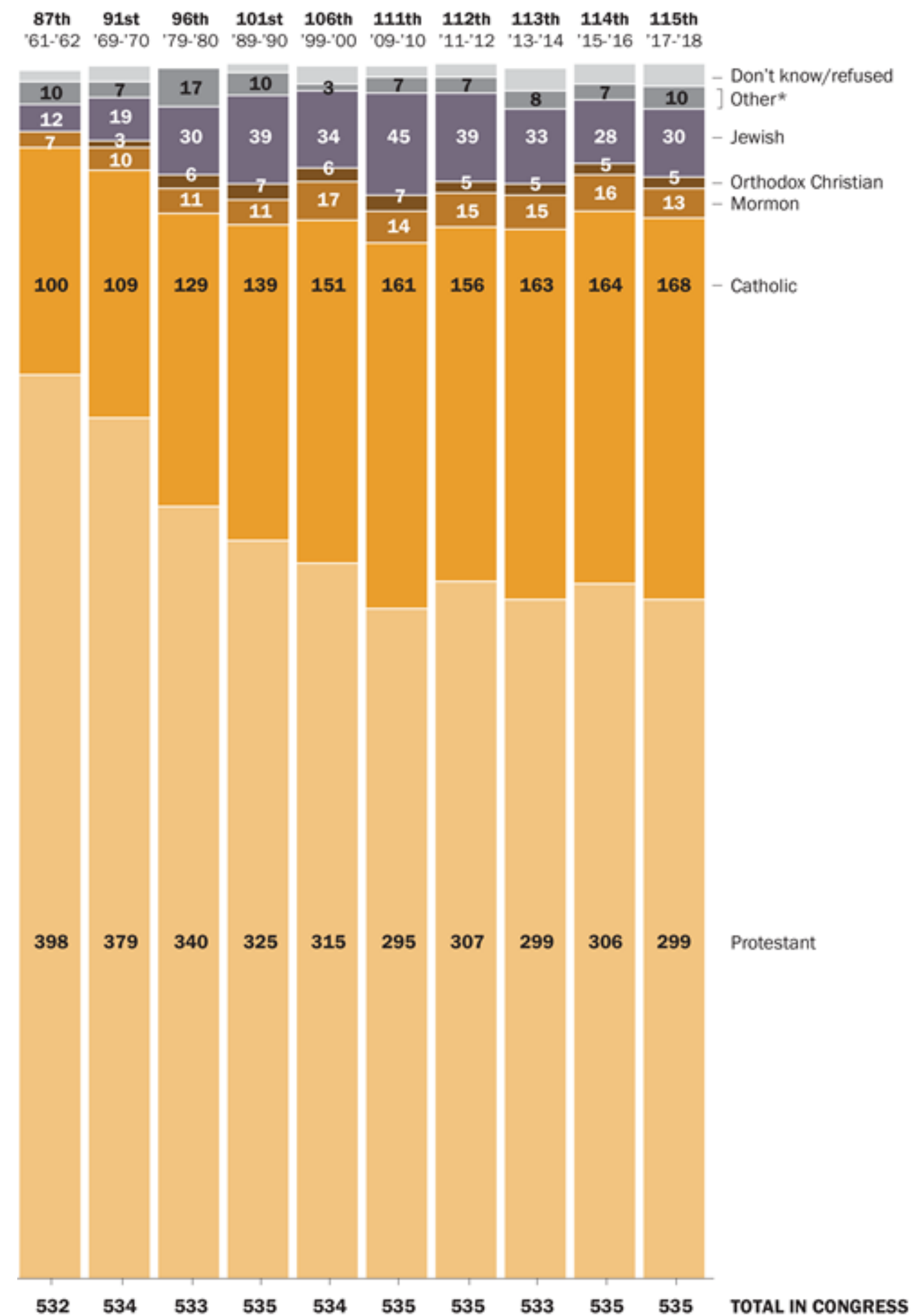
