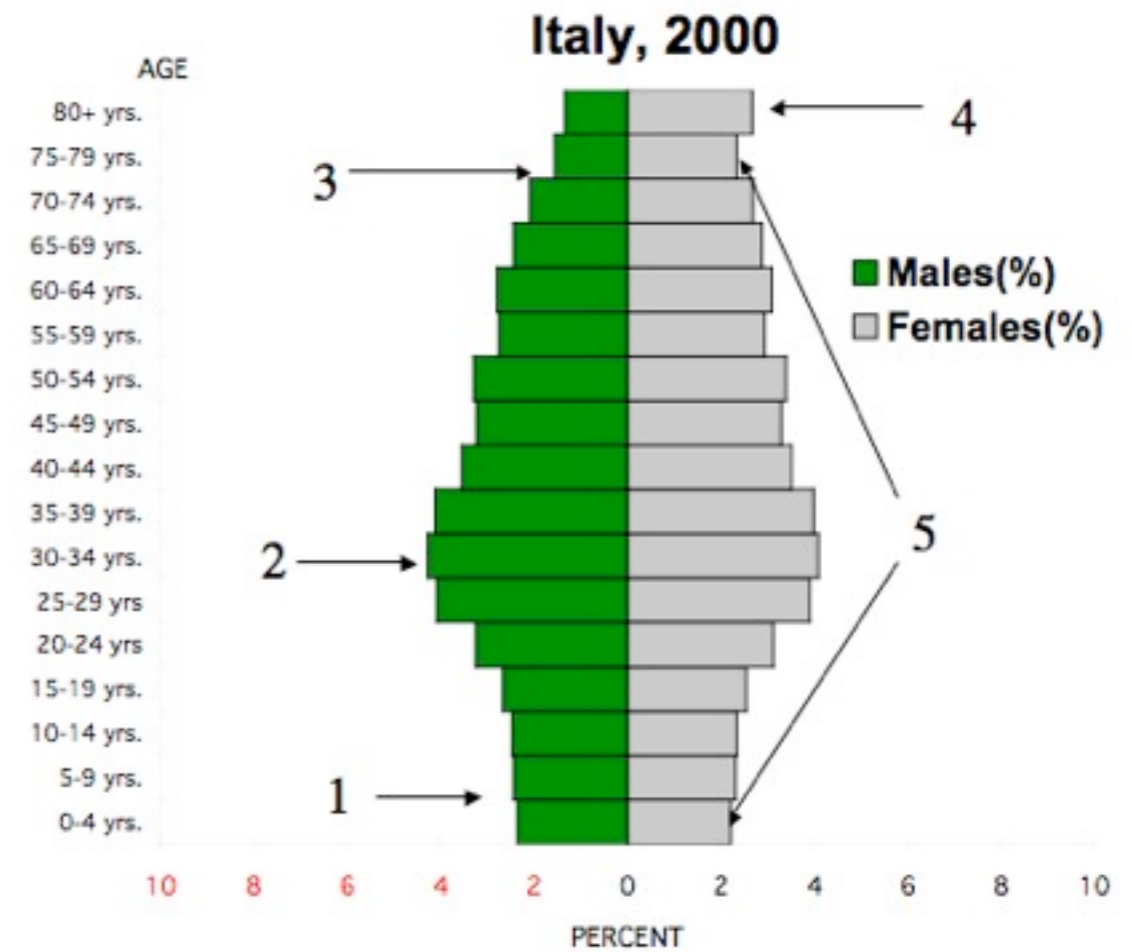


Analysis of Italy's Population Pyramid

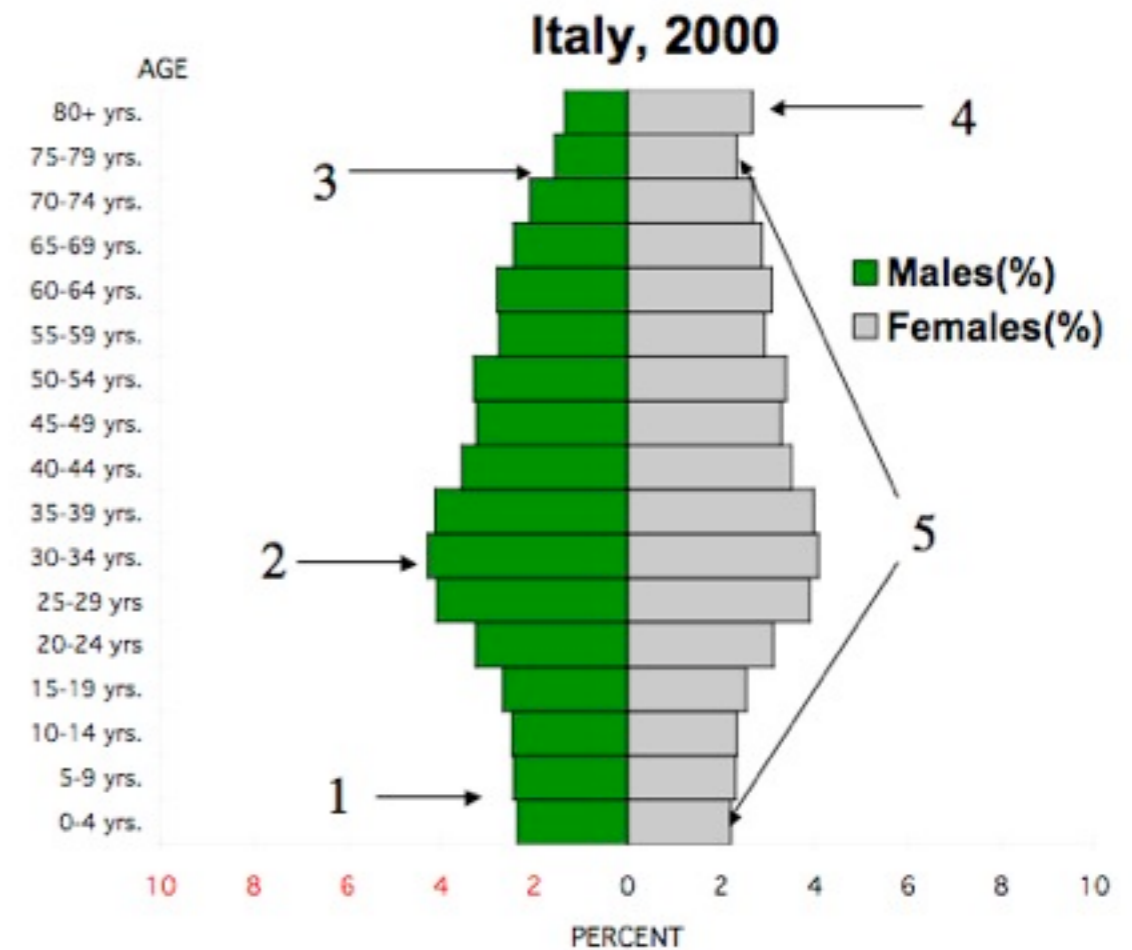
